For the second year in a row, the Norton Country Club team emerged as the winner of the one-day tournament. Once a 20-minute rain delay passed, the conditions were ideal.

Norton's 11-man team won the championship with a two-stroke victory over Goodland.

Atwood was a close third, followed by Colby in fourth place. The next eight spots went to Burlington, St. Francis, Sharon Springs, Tribune, Oakley, Benkelman, Hoxie and Oberlin.

Kevin Cox of Sharon Springs was the medalist for the event, shooting a two-under-par score of

69. Individual runners up were Joe Herman of Norton and Kevan Taylor of Colby, both with par scores of 71.

Golfers coming in at 73 included Dax Hayden of Goodland, Jason Kanak of Atwood, John Penny and Tyson Shelley of Burlington and Cole Nondorf of Hoxie.

Shooting 74 were Jon McLean of Goodland, Brandon Wagoner of Sharon Springs, and John Millan of Norton.

St. Francis' best efforts came from Dale Crabtree and Chris Bracelin with scores of 78.

Dick Ahlberg shot a 76 from Oberlin, and Stan Stark had a 75 to lead Oakley.

Shawn Jones paced Benkelman with a 78 and Rich Wieser and Scott Schneider both shot 79 for Tribune.

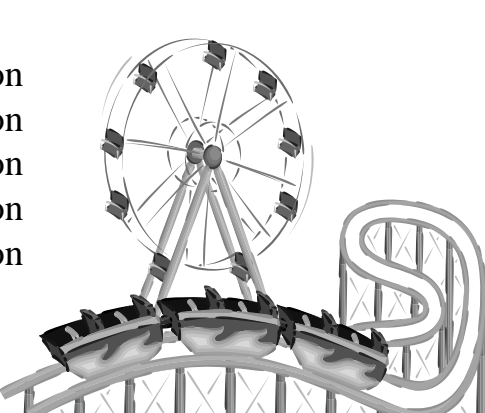
