The Lady Tigers are 13-0 for the season including victories over two nationally-ranked teams. This includes a 3-2 home-court win Sept. 16 against the University of Nebraska at Kearney to snap a 23match losing streak to the Lady Lopers. Nebraska-Kearney was ranked No. 12 at the time.
