Pursuant to K.S.A. 19-27a02(j)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SHERMAN COUNTY, KANSAS, being in regular session in its office of the County Courthouse in Sherman County, Kansas, on this 9th day of September, 2003, that the sewer district created by the Sherman County Commissioners under Home Rule Resolution No. 92-19 on the 22 nd day of September, 1992, is no longer necessary for the health and well-being of citizens of Sherman County and National Sun Industries (NSI).

WHEREAS, the Board of Sherman County Commissioners hereby resolve that said sewer district shall be disorganized by order of the Sherman County Commissioners, pursuant to K.S.A. 192786g.

WHEREAS, notice of disorganization of the sewer district servicing NSI is given by publication in The Goodland Star-News, the official city newspaper, once a week for three consecutive weeks.

WHEREAS, all fees, costs

and funds remaining in said improvement (sewer) district after the payment of all debts of such district shall be credited to the general fund of Sherman County, Kansas.

WHEREAS, a public hearing will be held on the 7th day of October, 2003, at 8:30 a.m. o'clock A.M., in the Sherman County Commissioners' room at the Sherman County Courthouse, to consider any objections to the disorganization of said sewer district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Sherman County that the sewer district, referred to as Sherman County Wastewater Disposal Dist. be disorganized, effective October 7th , 2003.


