Sectionals next on Oct. 25 in Scott City

The Goodland Star-News The annual Punt, Pass and Kick competition began at Cowboy Stadium at 9 a.m. Saturday as part of the Flatlander Fall Festival organized by the Godland Activities Center. The participants were separated into age groups: For boys 7 and under, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13 and 14-15; and for girls 10-11 and 12-13.

Stations were set up for each of the three events with the groups rotating between them. Each event was measured for distance and accuracy. The total yardage for each participant determined his or her place.

Winning the boys 14-15 was Casey Henderson with T.J. Hawkins second and Forrest Trachsel third. First for boys 12-13 was Keegan Smith with Eric Linnell second and John McCool third. In the boys 10-11 group, first went to Tate Andrews, second to Eric Whalen and third to Dallas DeLaRosa.

Erika Gonzales won the girls 12-13 competition with Michelle Smith second and Chelsie Gausman third. First for girls 10-11 was Angie Hillmer with Mary Williams second.

Gavin Mote won the boys 8-9 group with Derek Matthews second. Sheldon Nelson and Ryan Hillmer tied for third place. Ian Bonsall won the boys 7 and under competition with Causim Entwistle getting second and Jaden Schmidt third.

All first place winners, except the 7 and under group, qualify for the sectional competition Oct. 25 in Scott City.

Also Saturday morning a 3-on-3 basketball tournament for grammar school age children was held in the activities center which lasted through most of the afternoon. There were three brackets; 3rd and 4th grade boys, 5th and 6th grade boys and 5th and 6th grade girls.

Winning the 3rd and 4th grade boys bracket was the team of Dallas DeLaRosa, Reed Bellamy and Blaine Luther. First place in the girls 5th and 6th grade bracket went to Ashley Archer, Jade Herl and Jaylyn Reed. Both teams were from Goodland. The team of Tate Andrews, Nick Basgall and Trevor Bicker, from Sharon Springs, won the 5th and 6th grade boys competition.
