The fourth, for 15 minutes, began at 7:37 p.m.. Lutters said he was not making any more motions. Daniels made the motion, seconded by Garcia. It was during this executive ses-

sion that Lutters walked out at 7:50 p.m.

The next closed session was for 10 minutes at 7:56 p.m. The sixth was for 5 minutes at 8:10 p.m. Billinger said everything had been agreed to except the question of a raise.

The seventh was for 10 minutes at 8:17 p.m., and Pickman was asked to join the session so they

could discuss the contract and seek his approval.

The commission returned to open session at 8:25 p.m. and a motion was made to approve the contract.

The meeting adjourned at 8:28 p.m., and afterward every member of the commission shook Pickman's hand and said that he was doing a good job.
