# Goodland native wins leadership award

A Goodland native received a Leadership in Technology Award from the Houston Chapter of the National Association for Women in Computing this summer.

Sharon Fortmeyer-Selan, daughter of Darle and Eileen Fortmeyer of Goodland, was among 21 women from 16 companies recognized at a dinner and reception.

Fortmeyer-Selan, as a member of the Houston Technology Center's Service Provider Network, has created marketing plans for client companies, including Vuico, LLC and FrogPad.

For Vuico, she developed brand-

ing, packaging and pricing for GoWireless and connectWireless. While at FrogPad, she created branding, positioning, launch strategy and marketing plans.

The center is a business accelerator that incubates emerging technology companies in several sectors — energy, information technology, life sciences, nanotechnology and NASA technologies.

In the new 26,000-square-foot Houston Technology Center, client companies receive in-depth business guidance, and Houston's under employed receive training to participate in the information economy.

The Association for Women in Computing was formed in 1978 to encourage women in technology-related careers. The Houston chapter is among the largest and oldest in the country.
