**Public Notice**

Effective March 1, 2004, the City Commission adopted new sewer rates for the City of Goodland utility customers. The new rate is based upon the customer's water consumption and charged at the rate of \$1.10 per 100 cubic feet of water used plus a monthly minimum charge of \$4.43. All citizens will see the rate change on the utility bill that comes out in March 2004.

The new rates adopted are as follows:

**RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS:** The monthly sewer rate is based on the average monthly water usage during the months of December, January, and February. The monthly rate will be recalculated annually using the consumption for these months. Therefore, your monthly rate for the next year beginning March 1, 2004 will be based upon the average water consumption for December 2003, January and February 2004. If a customer has not established an average, their monthly charge will be the median charge of ALL other Residential contributors, until an average can be established.

**NON-RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS:** Monthly user charges will be based on the water used during the current month. If you have a sprinkler system on the same meter as your business, you may want to consider separating the sprinkler service to avoid paying sewer charges on the water used by the sprinkler system. The cost to separate the sprinkler service shall be the responsibility of the customer. The City's Code Officer and Utility Department will be happy to assist you in determining the feasibility and cost of separating the services.
