Meth labs/use common in area

We continue to hear about meth labs and the use and abuse of the drug in rural north west Kansas. I would like to update you on this information and use it as a reminder to a serious and devastating drug which is effecting people of all ages, races and incomes.

Methamphetamine, which you may have heard referred to as Chalk, Crank, Croak, Crypto, Crystal, Fire, Glass, Meth, Speed, White Cross, Tweek, is an addictive stimulant drug that strongly activates certain systems in the brain.

Meth is a crystal-like powdered substance that sometimes comes in large rock-like chunks. When the powder flakes off the rock, the shards look like glass, which is another nickname for meth. Meth is usually white or slightly yellow, depending on the purity.

Methamphetamine can be taken orally, injected, snorted or smoked. What are its short-term effects? Immediately after smoking or intravenous injection, the methamphetamine user experiences an intense sensation, called a "rush" or "flash," that lasts only a few minutes and is described as extremely pleasurable.

What are its long-term effects? Meth is addictive, and users can develop a tolerance quickly, needing more to get high, and going on longer binges.

Users often obsessively scratch their skin to get rid of these imagined insects. Long-term use, high dosages or both can bring on full-blown toxic psychosis (often exhibited as violent, aggressive behavior).
