Tuition is \$55,000 per credit hour for Kansas residents; \$95,00 per credit hour for non-residents; \$66,00 per credit hour for special non-residents. Some classes have additional fees. Special non-residents are any residents of Colorado and Nebraska.

There is an additional Technology Fee of \$5.00 per semester.
