## Cowgirls bitten by Bulldogs

The Cowgirls ended the first part of the basketball season with a loss Friday at Quinter, 57-48, dropping their season record to 3-2 at the Christmas break.

The next action for the team will be Friday, Jan. 9, against the Colby Lady Eagles at Max Jones Fieldhouse.

Coach Terry Daise said he would have liked to go into the break with a win, but it was not to be. The Cowgirls were unable to stay focused and had 18 turnovers in the first half.

The girls took an early 4-0 lead, but the Quinter Lady Bulldogs went on an 11-2 run to take the lead 11-6 with 2:15 left in the first quarter.

Cowgirl Whitney Archer hit the first of her two 3-point baskets to cut the lead to two 11-9 with less than two minutes left.

All of the Goodland starters were on the bench and Whitney Carmichael and Emily Murray hit baskets to stay close 15-13 at the end of the first quarter.

With two minutes gone in the second quarter, Archer hit her second 3-point basket to give the Cowgirls the lead 16-15, and a minute later a basket by Justeen Koehler that gave Goodland the lead again 18-17.

Two minutes later, Quinter's Callie Coberly hit to take the lead back 19-18. Dani Bedore took the lead back for the Cowgirls, 20-19 with 2:30 left.

However, that was the last time the Cowgirls were close. The Lady Bulldogs went on a 7-point run to lead 27-20 at the half.

At the half, the Cowgirls had 11

rebounds, 2 offensive and 9 defensive, to 6 rebounds for Quinter, 4 offensive and 2 defensive. The Cowgirls hit 53 percent of their shots in the first half while the Lady Bulldogs hit 46 percent.

In the third quarter, Koehler got two quick baskets to cut the Quinter lead to three, 27-24. That was as close as the Cowgirls could come, as Quinter continued to extend the lead, and had it up to 10 points, 38-28, with three minutes left in the quarter.

Murray had two baskets and two free throws in the last two minutes, but the Cowgirls were down by eight, 41-33, heading into the final eight minutes.

Cowgirl Jessica Osborn tried several three-point shots, but they refused to fall, and despite good defense and rebounding, the Cowgirls were unable to cut into the lead. They were down 47-35 midway through the final quarter.

Baskets by Bedore and Murray again cut the lead to single digits, 42-49, but Quinter got the next points to extend it back to 11, 42-53.

Again Osborn's 3-point shot would not fall, but she did get a steal and a lay-up for her two points, 55-48.

The final points were by Quinter's Brittany Wilson, who put in two free throws to make it 57-48.

There were four Cowgirls in double figures with Bedore leading with 11 points and Murray, Koehler and Archer each had 10. Osborn, Carmichael and Cortney Schields each had 2 and Megan Leonard had 1 point.

The Cowgirls shot 43 percent for the game while the Lady Bulldogs shot 56 percent. From the floor the Cowgirls hit 43 percent (18/42) and 29 percent of their 3-point shots (2/7), while the Lady Bulldogs hit 39 percent of their field goal (24/61) and none of their 3-point baskets (0/3).

At the free throw line the Lady Bulldogs hit 56 percent (9/16) and the Cowgirls hit 43 percent (6/14).

The Cowgirls out rebounded Quinter 27 to 22. The Lady Bulldogs had 9 offensive rebounds and 13 defensive while the Cowgirls had 6 offensive rebounds and 21 defensive rebounds.

Jerree Selensky was high scorer for the Lady Bulldogs with 15 points. Coberly had 13, Wilson 11, Jocelyn Anderson had 10, Kassie Harvey 4 and Michaela Bird had 2 points.
