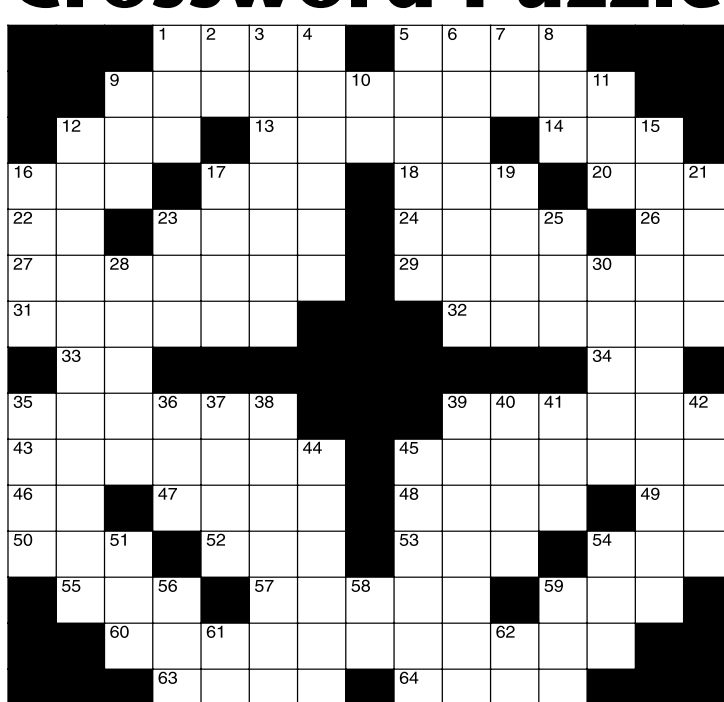

**Cowgirls lose in overtime**

In a game filled with turn overs and missed shots, the Cowgirls lost to the Oberlin Lady Red Devils on Friday, 46-43 in overtime.

The Cowgirls have a record of 10-3 for the season.

The next game for the Cowgirls is tonight at 5:30 p.m. (Mountain Time) in Garden City.

"We are in a very competitive league," said Coach Don Smith. Oberlin had a good volleyball team so you would expect some good athletes going out for basketball.

Whitney Archer sank the first basket for the Cowgirls at 6:27 in the first quarter. At 5:43 the Cowgirls lead by two but the Lady Red Devils tied the game at 4:24 and led eight to six at the end of the first quarter.

The Oberlin team led from two to

five points throughout most of the second quarter. At the end of the second quarter Oberlin led 17 to 15.

In the second half the lead went back and forth between Goodland and Oberlin. At the end of the third quarter the score was 22-24 and the fourth quarter ended in a tie at 40-40. The game then went into overtime.

In overtime Oberlin sank the first basket and were leading 44 to 40 with 48 seconds left. Archer made a three-point shot to bring Oberlin's lead to 44 to 43. With five seconds remaining Oberlin's Lauren Fortin made two free throws making the score 46-43.

Goodland made 26.3 percent of their three-point attempts with Oberlin making 16.7 percent of theirs. Archer had the only two free throws which she made. Goodland made 30.2 percent of their two-

point shots with Oberlin making 48.6 of theirs.

The top scorer was Archer with 18, followed by Kaylee Billinger with 13, Emily Murray six, Nicolette Clancy four and Sammie Raymer two.

The top scorers for Oberlin were Sarah Murray with 19 and Tricia Dorshorst 18.

Archer had 10 rebounds, Murray eight, Billinger four, Clancy four, Raymer four and Lindsay Schields one.

"We struggled," said Coach Smith. "We will have a tough week ahead and we need to bring renewed energy to the game."

Friday the Cowgirls will play St. Francis at 5:30 at Max Jones Fieldhouse. The Cowgirls will play Dodge City there at 3:30 (Mountain Time) on Saturday.
