States mail addressed to the office of the City Clerk of said City or by personal delivery of the same to said person, of his duly authorized agent for receiving the same, and if said notice be addressed to said Franchisee, the same shall be delivered by either first class United States Mail addressed to any officer of said Franchisee or its resident agent, or by personally delivering the same to such person as herein above provided, or such other person as said Franchisee shall from time to time direct.

b. The Franchisee shall assume the cost of publication of this franchise when such publication is required by law. A bill for publication costs shall be presented to the Franchisee by the City Clerk.

SECTION 18 FORCE MAJEURE It shall not be a breach or default under this Ordinance if either party fails to perform its obligations hereunder due to force majeure. Force majeure shall include, but not be limited to, the following: 1) physical events such as acts of God, landslides, lightning, earthquakes, fires, freezing, storms, floods, washouts, explosions, breakage or accident or necessity of repairs to machinery, equipment or distribution or transmission lines; 2) acts of oth-

ers such as strikes, work-force stoppages, riots, sabotage, insurrections or wars; 3) governmental actions such as necessity for compliance with any court order, law, statute, ordinance, executive order, or regulation promulgated by a governmental authority having jurisdiction; and (4) any other causes, whether of the kind herein enumerated or otherwise not reasonably within the control of the affected party to prevent or overcome. Each party shall make reasonable efforts to avoid force majeure and to resolve such event as promptly as reasonably possible once it occurs in order to resume performance of its obligations hereunder; provided, however, that this provision shall not obligate a party to settle any labor strike.

SECTION 19 SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid by the decision of any court or regulatory body of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions. The validity of any portion of this ordinance shall not abate, reduce, or otherwise affect any consideration or other obligation required of the Franchisee.

SECTION 20 CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION City ac-

knowledges that certain information it might request from Franchisee pursuant to this Ordinance may be of a proprietary and confidential nature, and that such requests may be subject to the Homeland Security Act or other confidentiality protections under state or federal law. If Franchisee requests that any information provided by Franchisee to City be kept confidential due to its proprietary or commercial value, City and its employees, agents and representatives shall maintain the confidentiality of such information, to the extent allowed by law. If City is requested or required by legal or administrative process to disclose any such proprietary or confidential information, City shall promptly notify Franchisee of such request or requirement so that Franchisee may seek an appropriate protective order or other relief.

SECTION 21 REPEAL. Prior Franchise Ordinance No. 1250 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 22 ADOPTION. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
