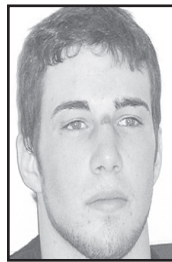


Goodland undefeated at Holiday Classic

The Cowboys went undefeated in duals against other teams to win the Holiday Classic on their home mats, with one Cowboy tied for Outstanding Wrestler and another scoring the fastest pin.

With a small field — five of 12 teams could not make it because of the weather — Goodland had a dominant team.

It was Goodland freshman Seth Miller with the fastest pin in 13 seconds, while senior A.J. Stephens tied with Dodge City's Jesse Barber for outstanding wrestler.

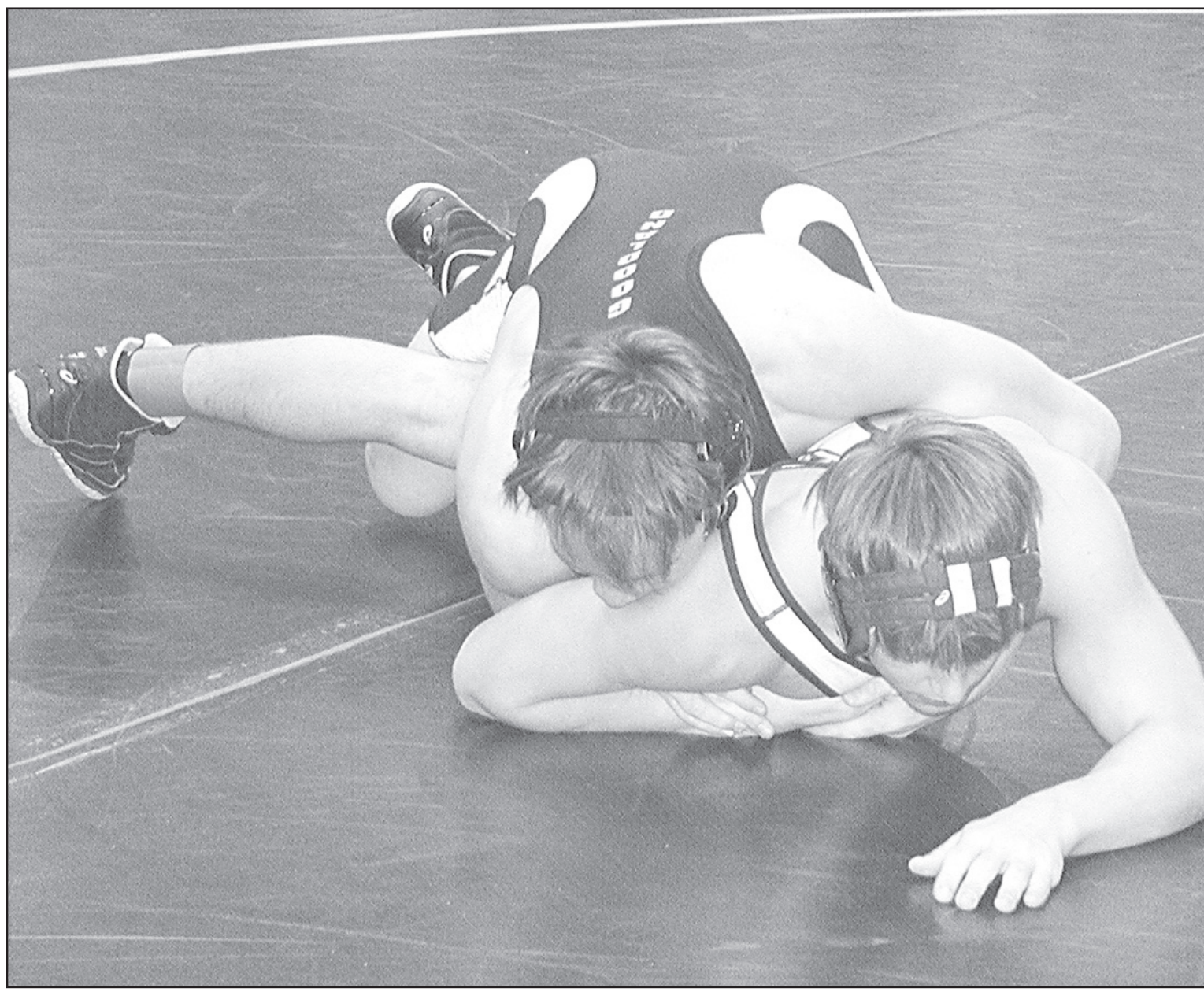
The Cowboys had six wrestlers go undefeated in their matches:

- Junior Kade Sheldon at 112 pounds, three pins, a 10-5 decision and a 7-1 win.
- Stephens at 140, two pins, one forfeit, an 8-3 decision and a technical fall (23-8).
- Senior Aaron Deeds at 152, four pins and a 5-0 decision.
- Junior Ryan Taylor at 160, one forfeit, a technical fall (18-2), and decisions by 11-8, 9-0 and 7-1.
- Junior Fernando Martinez at 189, four pins and one forfeit.
- Senior Bob Doxon at 285, three pins and two forfeits.

Seven teams made it to the tournament, said Coach Joseph Sramek, and five cancelled. To make an even number of teams, coaches formed Team X with junior varsity wrestlers from Goodland and Scott City.

"Overall, it was good tournament and our team took first out of the seven teams," Sramek said. "I feel the wrestling team had a good finish before Christmas break."

The Cowboys beat Buhler 48-21 in the first round. Sheldon beat Dallas Lawrence 7-1, Nathan Deeds beat Michael Schael 5-1 at 130, Stephens pinned Daryn

Young, junior Keegan Smith beat Logan Stoss 12-1 at 145, Aaron Deeds pinned Josh Brooks, Taylor beat Mitch Wiens by technical fall, junior Vance Johnson beat Dylan Young 2-1 at 171, Fernando Martinez pinned Nick Flowers, senior Ren Scherling pinned John Leeper at 215 and Doxon beat Taryn Riney

by forfeit. Miller was pinned by Anthony Negrette, freshman Kayler Rietcheck was pinned by Austin Ortiz at 125 and sophomore Lorenzo Delgado lost to Gus Garcia 9-4 at 135. Goodland was open at 103 in all the rounds. Goodland beat Team X 69-3 in

Round 2. Sheldon pinned Zach Niles of Scott City, Miller pinned Valdenar of Scott City, Rietcheck pinned Parson of Scott City and Aaron Deeds pinned Averitt of Scott City.

Nathan Deeds, Stephens, Smith, Taylor, Martinez, Scherling and Doxon all won by forfeit. Johnson

beat Starr 4-0, and Delgado lost to Alex Bruner of Scott City 12-7. Both teams were open at 103.

In Round 3, Goodland beat Garden City 42-30. Sheldon beat Colt McElroy 10-5, Stephens beat Joey Dozier 23-8, Smith pinned Anthony Shockley, Taylor beat Adrian McElroy 9-0, Johnson pinned Rome,

Martinez pinned Huberto Adrinie and Doxon pinned Stapleton.

Miller lost to A. Agirro by technical fall (16-1), Rietcheck was pinned by Lane Greenlee, Nathan Deeds lost to Jaime Quintanar 17-6, Delgado was pinned by Michael Arellano, and Scherling lost 3-2 to Bean.

In Round 4, Goodland beat Scott City 45-33. Sheldon pinned Kent Borman, Nathan Deeds pinned K. Kough, Stephens pinned Morgan Numrich, Aaron Deeds pinned Justin Groth, Taylor beat Chaston Hoeme 11-8, Martinez pinned Rylee Ward, Scherling pinned Calvin Erven and Doxon pinned Juan Garcia.

Miller was pinned by Tyrel George, Rietcheck was pinned by Jesus Contreras, Delgado lost to Sam McDaniel 4-2, Smith was pinned by Dakota Hayes and Johnson Logan Numrich.

Miller was pinned by Jesse Barber, Rietcheck lost to Jacob Bruton 17-0 and Delgado lost to Addison Winger 8-3.
