ORDINANCE NO. 1587

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE RETAIL SALE OF CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES AND ESTABLISHING LICENSING FEES AND THE PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING A LICENSE AND REPEALING SECTION 4 OF CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 15 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. All applications for a license to sell cereal malt beverages at retail in original and unopened containers and not for consumption on the premises shall be accompanied by a license fee of \$50.00 and all applications for the sale of cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises shall be accompanied by a fee of \$150.00.

SECTION 2: Section (4) of Charter Ordinance No. 15 of the Code of the City of Goodland is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Goodland Star News.

SECTION 1. Section 7-113 of the Code of the City of Goodland, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Residential refuse collection service fees.

(a) All residential refuse customers within the City of Goodland shall be charged a base rate for the collection of refuse in the amount of \$15.00 per month. The base rate includes one collection of refuse, and the tipping fee for such collection, each week

(b) All rural residential refuse customers shall be charged a base rate for the collection of refuse in the amount of \$17.00 per month. The base rate includes one collection of refuse and the tipping fee for such collection, each week.

SECTION 2. Section 7-114 (a) of the Code of the City of Goodland, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) All Class A commercial refuse customers within the City of Goodland shall be charged a base rate for the collection of refuse in the amount of \$14.00 per month. The base rate includes one container with one collection of refuse each week. In addition there is a tipping fee of \$2.10 per collection per container. Any additional containers shall be charged the same fee.

SECTION 3. Section 7-113 and Section 7-114 (a) of the Code of the City of Goodland are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Goodland Star News, but not before sixty (60) days after its final passage all pursuant to K.S.A. 12-2001 (b)(6).

ORDINANCE NO. 1589

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1577 OF THE CITY, WHICH DESIGNATES CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS, AS MAIN TRAFFICWAYS.

WHEREAS, the City of Goodland, Kansas (the "City") has, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-685 *et seq.*, passed Ordinance No. 1577 (the "Original Ordinance") which designates certain streets in the City as main trafficways; and

WHEREAS, the governing body finds and determines that it is necessary to amend the Original Ordinance to amend and change the designation of portions of 11th Street in the City as main trafficways,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

Section 1. Amendment of Exhibit A. In Exhibit A to the Original Ordinance, the main trafficway designation relating to 11th Street is hereby repealed and the designation relating to 11th Street shall now read as follows:

Street Name	Location
11 th Street	from Cattletrail to Caldwell; and Arcade to College.

Section 2. Ratification of Original Ordinance; Further Authorization. The Original Ordinance, as amended by this amending Ordinance, is ratified and confirmed and the Mayor, Clerk and other officials of the Issuer are authorized to take such actions as are necessary to effectuate the intent of this amending Ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This amending Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication once in the official City newspaper.
