

he older kids had a different set of targets than the younger kids. Both groups got three practice kicks before doing a series of 15 kicks with points ranging from 1 to 5 depending on where the kick went.

The older group had net strung across a softball backstop, and the holes in the net were worth different points. The bottom was worth one point while getting the soccer ball up and through the top was worth five points. The maximum number of points for the older group was 75.

For the younger kickers they had a series of five goals to shoot at, and the number of points per goal went up as the goals got narrower. The kicker got three shots at each of the five goals, and the narrowest was worth five points per kick. The total possible score was 45 points for the younger kickers.

Chelsea Philips was the winner in the girls under 8 division with five points.

Andrew Wood won the boys under 8 with 16 points, and David Wood was the other participant in that division.

Evan Peter won the boys under 10 with 34 points. Other participants in that group included Mathew Wood, Tucker Harkins, Chase Johnson and Lucas Wood. (No girls kicked in the under 10 division.)


Makayla Kennedy won the girls under 12 with 27 points. Alia Lucas was a participant.


