Burlington wins Levi Hayden Legion tourney

At the end of the event, the coaches, umpires, and announcer named Garrett Tacha from Hoxie, who plays for Norton, as the most inspirational player.

Goodland won it's first game against Norton 10-4 on Saturday, then took Scott City into extra innings on Sunday before losing 7-6. The game went well over the onehour, 45-minute time limit, making it the longest of the tournament at 2 1/2 hours.

Goodland was down 6-1 going into the fifth inning, but rallied to score five runs to tie the game. Scott

Dautel was the starting pitcher;




