Amid safety concerns about
Salmonella contamination on to-
matoes, stores and restaurants have
pulled the suspecttypes of tomatoes
from the shelves or quit serving
them.
The U.S. Food and Drug Admin-
istration warned consumers about
a nationwide salmonella outbreak
linked to consumption of certain
red, raw tomatoes, particularly
red Roma, red plum and red round
tomatoes.
As of Thursday, the FDA listed
those tomatoes as not part of the
outbreak orcherry and grape toma-
toes, including ones sold with the
vine still attached and those grown
athome. Since mid-April, more than
160 cases of salmonella, alsoknown
as food poisoning which produces
