In 1943, the French entomologist August Magnan argued that, according to the known laws of physics, the bumblebee shouldn't be able to fly. He stated: "Virtually all insects flap their wings through a wide arc, about 165 degrees. Frequency generally varies with size: The larger the insect, the slower the wings beat. Mosquitoes, for example, beat their wings about 400 times per second (those things are huge up in Alaska, and they sound like 747's!), fruit flies about 200. Birds beat their wings much more slowly-about 50 times per second for humming birds. But bees, which are 80 times as large as fruit flies, flap their wings 230 times per second through an arc of about 90 degrees. And although most insects
