

# Slammers take top individual awards

The Goodland Slammers fastpitch softball team took three top individual awards at the Burlington Thunder on the Plains tournament and finished second against tough Colorado teams.

Coach Andy Scheopner said the girls played well, and faced two all-star teams from southern Colorado including the Lamar All-Star Team which was made up of the best players from the Lamar teams who have finished their local season. He said Lamar has won the state championship the past two years and the Southern Plains All-Stars was third last year at the state. He said that team is made up of all-star players from towns surrounding Lamar as far north as Cheyenne Wells.

Goodland lost to the Lamar All-Star Team in the championship 12-5.

Scheopner said the girls played hard, and feels they are getting better with each game. The Slammers played against Grainfield on Wednesday at the Centennial Park ball complex. The team will play in a round robin in Oakley on Wednesday with Oakley and Grainfield.

Scheopner said he is trying to get a few teams together for a tournament on the July 12 weekend because of the break between the Oakley round robin and a game with Oakley in Goodland on Wednesday, July 16 two days before the state tournament.

He said the state tournament this year will be July 18-20 in Emporia. He said it was much closer last year in Salina.

Scheopner said he was proud that Stephani DeLaRosa was named most valuable player at Burlington and Berkley White the best offensive player. He felt it was a great testament to the efforts even though the team finished second. The awards were voted on by the team coaches, umpires and announcers he said.

Scheopner said he was proud to be named the coach of the tournament.

On Saturday the Slammers defeated the Brush Beet Diggers, 12-5

in three innings with DeLaRosa pitching the first two and Selana Acosta pitching the third inning. DeLaRosa gave up 2 hits, 2 runs, walked 5 and struck out 6 in the two innings. Acosta gave up 1 hit, 3 runs, walked 3 and struck out 1 in her inning.

Hope Cochran had a double and scored 2 runs; Berkley White had 2

singles and 2 rbi's; Brianna White had a single and one rbi; Gabby Rangel scored 1 run; Megan Siruta scored 2 runs; Lindsay Bauman scored 1 run; and Amber Smith scored 1 run and had one rbi.

In the first game against Lamar on Saturday the Slammers lost 5-1 in five innings with DeLaRosa taking the loss. She gave up 5 hits, 5 runs,

walked 8 and struck out 6.

The Slammers had two hits with singles by Brianna White and Siruta. Rangel scored the only run on the rbi single by Siruta.

Sunday the Slammers played Burlington winning 12-0 in four innings behind Acosta's pitching. She gave up 1 hit, walked 4 and struck out 8.

In the semi-final game the Slammers beat the Southern Plains All-Stars 7-3.

DeLaRosa was the winning pitcher giving up 3 hits, walked 3 and struck out 8.

Scheopner said the team got off to a great start in the first inning as Cochran led off with a triple and DeLaRosa brought her in with a single. Berkley White walked and Brianna White hit a double to score both DeLaRosa and her sister.

"This was one of our best games of the season both offensively and defensively," Scheopner said.

In the championship game Lamar took an early 5-0 lead, but the Slammers battled back to tie it at 5-5 in the fourth inning. Lamar scored

two in the fifth and five in the sixth to win 12-5.

Acosta pitched three innings giving up 3 hits, 5 runs, walked 6 and struck out 3. DeLaRosa came in for the last three innings giving up 6 hits, 7 runs, walked 3 and struck out 6.

Cochran had a single and scored 1 run; DeLaRosa had 2 singles and 2 runs; Berkley White has a single and scored a run; Brianna White had 2 singles, 2 doubles, scored a run and had 3 rbi's; Siruta and Bauman each had a single.

"This was a really good tournament for us," Scheopner said. "We are starting to play really well and look forward to the next few weeks."
