# Brothers win Drive, Chip, Putt

Two Goodland brothers who enjoy playing golf participated in the Drive, Chip and Putt competition in June held at Cherokee Ridge Golf Course in Colorado Springs with one winning a putting championship and the second qualifying for the regional championship.

Tyler Jones, 14, and brother Thatcher, 11, were part of a field of 162 junior golfers ages 7 to 14 who participated in the Mutual of Omaha Drive, Chip & Putt Local Championship, presented by the Golf Channel on June 14.

Travis Jones, the boys father, said Tyler really gets into playing golf and puts all his 195 pounds behind every shot.

Tyler placed third overall in the 13-14 age group with a drive of 310 yards and that was good enough for second, and he got first place in the chipping with 18 points his dad said.

Tyler did not place in the putting with two putts from 15 feet and one put from 5 feet.

In the regional championship held that afternoon Tyler came close to winning a trip to the national father said, but his drive of 325 yards drifted out of bounds.

"It was a fun time. Tyler came within a foot of winning a trip to Florida," his father said. "The crowd was cheering him on, and then when the drive began to drift they were as disappointed as he was."

Brother Thatcher did not qualify for the regional competition, but he did win the putting championship in the 11-12 age group making both of his putts from 15 and from 5 feet.

The competition sponsored by Mutual of Omaha celebrated its 10th season for junior golfers between the ages of 7-14. Prizes were awarded in each of four age groups — one to each of the top five in driving, chipping and putting — as well as the top three rankings for the best combined overall performance. The top-three best combined performances advanced to the Colorado Regional Championship
