

Goodland third at league swim meet

The Goodland Swim Team ended its season with third place at the Northwest Kansas Swim League championship meet at Burlington on Friday and Saturday, July 11 and 12.

Goodland swimmers set one pool record, won 16 individual events and six relays.

Three won trophies for having the most points for the meet. Holton Witman (11-12 boys) won all five of his events, the 50-yard freestyle (28.69), 100-yard freestyle (1:06.18), 50-yard backstroke (38.18), 50-yard butterfly (32.69) and 100-yard individual medley (1:19.36) for 35 points.

Ashleigh Woodworth (8 and under girls) won four events, the 50-yard freestyle (40.14), 25-yard freestyle (17.90), 25-yard butterfly (22.33) and 100-yard individual medley (1:46.51) for 33 points.

Taryn Bedore (11-12 girls) tied for first in the 50-yard butterfly (35.81) and won the 100-yard individual medley (1:19.05) for 28 points.

Others winning gold medals were Teneille Whitham (13-14 girls), who won the 50-yard freestyle (27.97) and set a pool record in 100-yard breaststroke (1:17.74).

Winning one first were Powell Sieck (8 and under boys), 25-yard backstroke (25.41); Ian Bonsall (11-12 boys) 200-yard freestyle (2:36.40); and Zach Miller (11-12 boys) 50-yard breaststroke (42.68).

- 11-12 boys 200-yard freestyle (2:38.73) with Bonsall, Zach Miller, Holton Witman and Alec Hamilton;
- 11-12 boys 200-yard freestyle (2:13.29) with Bonsall, Gerell Miller, Zach Miller and Holton Witman.

Twelve swimmers received trophies for the season up to sixth place. Ashleigh Woodworth (8 and under girls), fifth with 76 points; Borgmann (8 and under girls), tied for third with 66; Powell Sieck (8 and under boys), second with 85; Chase Johnson (8 and under boys), fourth with 53; Peyton Sieck (8 and under boys), sixth with 48; Drew House (9-10 boys), fourth with 75; Hoss (9-10 boys), sixth with 70; Bedore (11-12 girls), second with 118; Zach Miller (11-12 boys), tie for first with 119; Holton Witman (11-12 boys), tie for first with 119; Bonsall (11-12 boys), third with 80; and Teneille Whitham (13-14 girls), sixth with 68.
