Rough Riders win

Goodland's Rough Riders 12-and-under baseball team closed out an undefeated season with three wins at the league tournament Friday and Saturday in Colby.

The A team beat Norton 11-1 on Friday, beat Colby 5-4 in a noon game Saturday and beat Colby again in the 3:30 game, 8-5. The team won the league with a 9-0 record for the season. Coaches were Kahle Helton, Kendall Helton and David Avila.

Against Norton, Goodland got five runs in the first inning. Gannon Ihrig led off with a double to right field and stole third, then his brother Gage hit a double to left. Gunner Helton was out on a play from second to first. Taylen Smith walked and then stole second, advanced to third on a wild pitch and stole home. Colton Cooper walked and stole second, third and home.

Drew Dautel made the second out, followed by Conner Simpson, who walked and stole second and third and scored on a wild pitch. Kolt Trachsel walked and stole second but was picked off trying to steal third.

Luke Avila led off the second with a walk and then stole second and third. Gannon Ihrig hit a double to left, followed by Gage's triple to left, Helton's double to left and Smith's triple to right. All of them scored.

In the third, Cooper hit a double to left and stole third. Dautel walked, Simpson was put out center to second, advancing Dautel and putting Cooper across the plate for Goodland's 11th run.

For Norton, it was three up and three down on strikeouts the first

two innings, then three walks and three stolen bases, leading to their only run in the third. Norton went three up and three down in the fourth.

Gage Ihrig pitched three innings and had four strikeouts, giving up four walks and one run but no hits. Gannon Ihrig pitched one and had two strikeouts and gave up no walks, hits or runs.

In Goodland's first game against Colby, Gannon Ihrig led off with a single, his brother Gage struck out and tried to run to first when the catcher dropped the ball, but was put out, and Helton was thrown out, shortstop to first. Smith hit a single, allowing Gannon Ihrig to score.

In the second, Dautel made the first out, and then Simpson got on base but failed to score, as Trachsel and Avila struck out.

Colby scored one in the first and fared no better than Goodland in the second, so the game entered the third tied. Colby scored three, but then ended the inning with three strikeouts.

For Goodland, Gannon Ihrig got a triple and Gage a double. Helton struck out, then Smith and Cooper each got singles, Dautel walked and Simpson got a single. Trachsel and Avila struck out to end the inning, but Goodland was up by one, as both Ihrigs, Smith and Cooper had scored. Colby was three up and three down in the fourth, ending the game.

Smith pitched all four innings and

had six strikeouts. He gave up seven walks, four hits and four runs and hit two batters.

In the 3:30 game, Gannon Ihrig was thrown out third to first, Gage got a single, but then Helton hit a fly to the right fielder and Smith struck out.

In the second, Cooper grounded out pitcher to first, then Dautel hit a double and scored on a single by Simpson. Trachsel popped to first and Avila struck out.

Colby had scored in the first but went three up and three down in the second. The teams went into the third tied, but Colby then took the lead, scoring two in the top of the inning.

Goodland took a commanding lead in the bottom of the inning with five runs. Gannon Ihrig hit a double, followed by Gage with a triple, Helton and then Smith with singles, Cooper with a triple and Dautel with a single. Cooper was put out trying to score and Dautel was picked off, then Simpson hit a homer. Both Ihrigs, Helton, Smith and Simpson all scored.

Colby got a double and a single in the fourth but failed to score. Goodland added two to the score with a double from Gannon Ihrig, Gage Ihrig hit by a pitch and a triple by Helton, sending both Ihrigs home. Colby added two more in the fifth.

Gannon Ihrig pitched five innings, had two strikeouts and gave up one walk, eight hits and five runs.
