## Sixty-four cars lined up for race on hot day

The weather was hot, but there was a good crowd in the shaded grandstand when 64 cars lined up for races at the Sherman County Speedway on Saturday, July 19.

Entries in some of the car classes were down, but overall 20 more cars were on the track than for the previous races.

In the mini stock division, Dalton Dolan of Oberlin (3D) won the main in his pickup. Tyrel Smith (car 12) of Goodland finished second with Eric Munoz (3M) of Lamar, Colo., third.

Randy Tipton (95) of Weskan, who had won five races in the International Motor Contest Association stock car class, finishing fourth with Tyler Hahn of Stockton (44T) winning for the first time. Wheat Lippleman (44) of Colby came in second and B.J. Wagner of Colby was third.

In the econo class, Cody Pancake (40) of Sharon Springs broke a string of wins by Goodland drivers, winning the main ahead of Chad Normandin (01) of Goodland. Dan Blair (86) of St. Francis finished third. Alex West (31), who has won three main events this season, finished 15th.

Donovan Nichols (44) of Goodland came in fourth and Chris Ross (39) of Burlington finished fifth. Adrienne West (7) of Goodland was sixth.

The Econos had an all-Goodland "B" main event won by Lee Hageman (4), with J.R. Wolfrum (11) second and Alex Crossland (77) third.

The IMCA hobby stock class drew eight cars, with Joey Carter (88J) of Russell winning the main over Richard Boon (33) of Benkelman, Neb. Jerry Wagner (29) of Kensington was third and Matthew Crowell (2C) of Clearwater was fourth. Allen Kurth (38) of Colby was fifth.

In the IMCA modified class, 22 cars were in the field, and Nick Tubbs (737) of Colby returned to win the main ahead of Matt Morris (21M) of Lamar, driving a car he bought from Darren DeLoach (21) of Lamar. Morris finished 13th on July 5.

DeLoach finished 20th on the night, and Brady Coen (3) of Wiley, who won the main on July 5, finished at the bottom at 22nd.

Adam Morris (8) of Lamar, who bought one of DeLoach's older cars,

finished eighth. Drew Miller (49) of Goodland finished 17th.

The next races will be the Bill Gray Memorial on Saturday, Aug. 16, starting at 6:30 p.m. The pits usually open about 2 p.m., and hot laps begin around 4:30 p.m.

The race night honors the late Bill Gray, a former member of the county fair board who was a staunch supporter of the speedway, said Doug Hilty, who used to drive a race car before a farm accident put him

in a wheel chair.

Hilty said the memorial races used to be held during the fair, but scheduling problems moved it later into August.

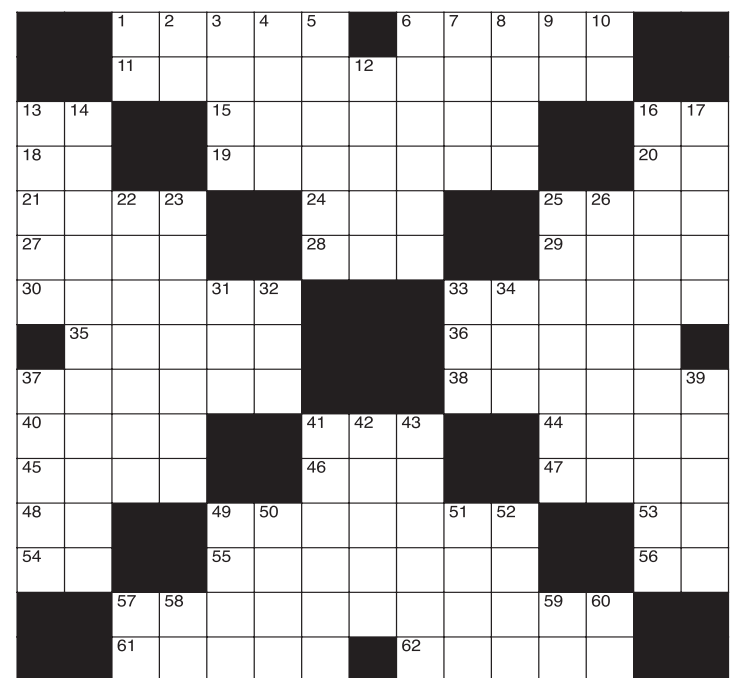
