
Challenges overcome by winners

Two of the most talked about United States athletes at the 2008 Olympics were swimmers Michael Phelps, winner of eight gold medals, seven World Records and one Olympic Record, and 41-year-old Dara Torres, winner of two silver medals and one American Record.

Their accomplishments in swimming were inspiring, as are the personal challenges that both had to overcome. Phelps suffered arom Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder as a child and Dara Torres struggled with bulimia, an eating disorder, in her early years as a college student and competitive swimmer.

Attention deficit disorder is one of the most common mental disorders in children and adolescents, most often diagnosed before the age of seven. The disorder is characterized by a child's difficulty in attention, concentration and impulsivity. If left untreated, children are at risk of academic failure in school and being ostracized or teased by their

tude Magazine (April/May 2007), Phelps was diagnosed at age nine. His mother said an inability to concentrate was his biggest challenge her college days at the University and that he would often impulsively grab other students' papers.

He did not enjoy reading and In fact, he did not like swimming at first because he "hated getting his face wet." Swimming eventually became his motivation for success, as it provided consistent structure for his busy days, an important component for a young person with the disorder.

This eventually resulted in Poor health, fatigue and loss of strength, which affected her performance at the 1988 Olympics. She recognized her problem by then and comments that it took her five years, until 1992, to overcome the purging behaviors. Since then she has experienced success in athletics, as well as in her personal life as the mother of a two-year-old daughter.
