

# Cowgirls tennis team ties for fourth

The Cowgirls finished in a tie for fourth Thursday at the Ulysses Invitational tennis tournament and will face tough competition in their home tournament Tuesday.

Goodland tied with Meade with nine points on Thursday. Scott City won the tournament with 18, and Liberal and Ulysses tied for second and third. Garden City's junior varsity team placed sixth.

In No. 1 doubles, Cowgirls seniors Kaitlin Fugleberg and Shonna Webster went 2-1 and finished third. They beat Ross and Harshberger

of Meade 6-1, then lost to Huck and Scheurman of Scott City 7-6 (7-3) after a tie-breaker match, then whipped Workman and Marsh of Liberal 6-2 for the third-place medal.

The tie-breaker loss to Scott City was the first of the year for Fugleberg and Webster; going into their home tournament, they have an 8-1 record. Five of the eight teams coming to Goodland have good No. 1 doubles teams, said Coach Wallace Hansen, so the competition will be keen.

In No. 1 singles, senior Sandra Redlin lost to Cordes of Meade 6-3, to Gunther of Scott City 6-3 and to Prentice of Garden City 6-2. The competition has been tough so far, Hansen said, but Redlin is improving in her first year playing No. 1 and has the rest of the season to look forward to.

In No. 2 doubles, Goodland's duo of junior Heidi Lawson and freshman Page Seeger went 1-2. They beat Murillo and Medrano of Garden City 6-2 but lost matches to Scribner and Gleason of Meade 6-2 and to Stockman and Chambless of Scott City 6-1.

In No. 2 singles, freshman Kate-

lyn Coon, playing in her first varsity matches, lost to Barth of Meade 6-1, Blair of Scott City 6-1 and Walz of Garden City 6-1.

The tournament starts at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Steever, Chambers and Gulick parks. Colby, Norton, Wa-Keeneey, Tribune, Ulysses, Garden City and Scott City round out the

field. This will be excellent competition, Hansen said, with most of the teams having quality players throughout their lineup.

The junior varsity girls go to Hays to compete at 2 p.m. Thursday at a six-team tournament.

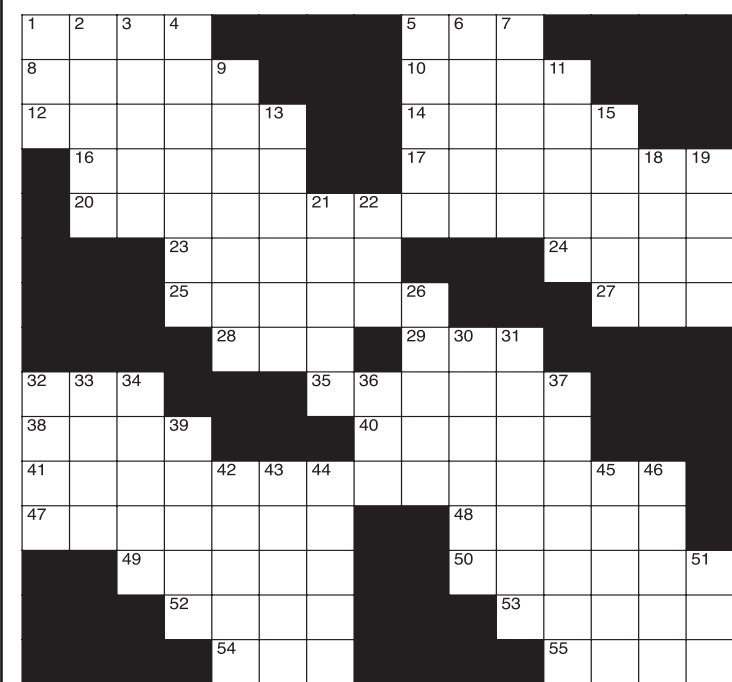


## Freshmen beat Colby Thursday
