There are almost twice as many suicides as homicides each year. It is the third leading cause of death among young people between the do. ages of 15 and 24.

In the elderly, the rate of suicide of people age 65 and older is higher than any other age group and the suicide rate in the Army is currently at a 26-year high.

The stigma associated with mental health treatment is one of the primary reasons why people do not seek help, which is unfortunate because treatment does work. Most suicidal individuals really don't want to die. They want to live, but are unable to deal with the emotional pain they are feeling and are unable to see alternatives or solutions to their problems.
