

Great weekend of racing for Flatlander Classic

Some of the top drivers in the International Motor Contest Association were in Goodland the last weekend in September for the Flatlander Fall Classic and gave the crowds two nights of great racing.

For some of the drivers in the IMCA divisions it was the last weekend to gain in the point standings, and David Murray, Jr., of Oberlin (car 97M) was leading by a narrow margin in the national modified standings, but when the weekend was over Murray finished fifth in the national standings. He finished second in the Central Regional standings.

Murray had won the Flatlander Classic last year, but found himself finishing third in the 'A' Main feature race on Friday and second on Saturday.

John Fabrizius (42) of Colby was another of the top regional modified drivers at the Sherman County Speedway finishing second in the 'B' Main No. 4 on Friday and then 14th in the 'A' Main feature. On Saturday Fabrizius won the 'B' Main No. 4 and finished 24th in the 'A' Main. Fabrizius was ranked 7th in the regional modified standings before the final weekend.

Jeff Tubbs (37) of Colby was another of the top modified drivers racing both nights finishing 7th in the main on Friday.

On Saturday Tubbs finished 4th in the 'B' Main No. 3 to make it into the main race. He finished 25th in

the 'A' Main on Saturday.

The two nights of racing were decidedly different as the hot weather on Friday had made the track hard and slick with a number of cars sliding off the track and it was reported that more than 60 tires were sold on Friday with 72 modified cars, 12 mini stock, 23 econos, 18 hobby

stock and 18 stock cars.

On Saturday the races were delayed for about 45 minutes while the cars mud packed the track, but most of the drivers agreed it was a better track on Saturday than they faced on Friday. Despite the wrecks on Friday no one was injured. One driver was taken by ambulance to

the hospital on Friday, but he was checked out and released.

In the mini stock division David Guinn (61) won the heat race on Friday with Don Kline (21) second, Brian Kline (11) third and Tyrel Smith (12) of Goodland fourth. On Saturday the drivers changed positions in the Pole Dash with Smith

winning and Brian Kline second, Don Kline third and Guinn fourth.

In the Main Feature on Saturday Don Kline was the winner with Scott Dubois (28) second, Brian Kline third and Smith was fourth. Smith was the Sherman County Speedway track champion this year.

The Econo division had a wild

weekend with Donovan Nichols (44), Alex West (31) and Mark Carmichael (21) winning the heat races on Friday. Nichols and West tied for track champion this year.

In the Pole Dash on Saturday West was in the lead until he spun out in turn one on the white flag lap allowing Nichols to win with Chad Normandin (001) second, Lee Hageman (4) third and West recovering enough to finish fourth.

Saturday Nichols won the Econo Main with Normandin second, Alex West third, Lee Hageman fourth and Dan Blair (86) fifth.

The Stock car division Main feature on Friday was won by Ryan Wark (8). Angel Munoz (2M) of Lamar, Colo. was second, Randy Tipton (95) of Weskan was third and Jeff Tubbs (37) was fourth. Tipton was the stock car track champion this year.

On Saturday the stock main feature had some new names on top with Jason Rogers (37) winning, Wark (8) second, Travis Sherfick (66) third and Wheat Lippelman (44) fourth.

In the Hobby stock division Josh Latka (96) was the winner of the Main on Saturday after finishing second in the main on Friday. Austin Davis (22) was second in the main on Saturday with Richard Boon (33) third and Cody Dewester (20) fourth.

Track champion in the Hobby stock division was Joey Snethen (S98).
