Trail ride Sunday near St. Francis

Last year, the weather turned cold and was rained out. The coordinators of the ride are hoping for better weather this year.

If the weather is bad on Oct. 12, the ride will be held the following Sunday, same place, same time.

The ride is planned each year on the second weekend in October. It is generally a little cooler and trees are turning colors.

Gary Cooper, one of the coordinators, said this will be a ride with more rough terrain than some of the

To reach the starting point from St. Francis, turn north on Benton Street off U.S. 36 and travel 3 miles (to transformers), around the curve northeast, then north 7.2 miles to Road H (approximately 10 miles. Turn east for 1/2 mile, then turn left and follow the lane to the park-

From Benkelman, go 13 miles west on U.S. 34 to Road 15 (Mills Hereford Ranch sign), then south 7.8 miles to Road Y, turn east and go 1/2 mile, then turn left and follow the land to the parking area.

From Haigler, go 8 miles east on U.S. 34 to Road 15 (Mills Hereford Ranch sign), then south approximately 7.8 miles to Road Y, turn east and go 1/2 mile then turn left and follow the lane to the parking area.
