The following are adult alcoholic beverages with a seasonal theme. They are from "Good Spirits" by A. J. Rathbun.

Phantasm Fizz

- ice cubes
- 1 1/2 ounces vodka
- 1 ounce heavy cream

- 1/2 ounce Galliano chilled club soda
- Fill a cocktail shaker halfway with ice cubes and add vodka, cream and Galliano. Shake well.
- Fill a highball glass with ice

cubes. Strain the mix over the ice. Top with club soda. Top with a touch of whipped cream.

Satan's Whiskers

- ice cubes
- 1 ounce gin
- 1 ounce dry vermouth
- 1 ounce sweet vermouth
- 1 ounce freshly squeezed orange juice
- 1/2 ounce Grand Maamier
- 2 dashes orange bitters

Fill a cocktail shaker halfway with ice cubes and add gin, dry and sweet vermouths, orange juice, Grand Marnier and orange bitters. Shake well.

Bloody Mary

- Strain into a large cocktail glass.
- 4 ounces tomato juice
- 3 ounces vodka
- 1 ounce freshly squeezed lemon juice
- 1 dash Louisiana-style hot sauce
- 1 dash Worcestershire sauce
- 1/4 teaspoon celery salt
- salt and freshly ground black

pepper
 celery stalk, dill pickle spear or pickled green bean for garnish
 Fill a pint glass three-quarters full with ice cubes. Add the tomato juice, vodka, lemon juice, hot sauce, Worcestershire sauce, celery salt and salt and pepper. Stir well. Add garnish.

Witch's Brew

- ice cubes
- 1 1/2 ounces Strega
- 1/2 ounce white creme de menthe
- 1/2 ounce freshly squeezed lemon

juice
 1/2 ounce freshly squeezed orange juice
 1/4 ounce Pernod
 lemon slice for garnish
 fresh mint sprig
 Fill cocktail shaker halfway full with ice cubes and add the Strega, creme de menthe, lemon juice and orange juice. Shake well.
 Strain into a cocktail glass. Float the Pernod on top. Garnish with the lemon slice or mint sprig.
