
pooky refreshments for adult Halloweeners

Fill a cocktail shaker halfway pepper over the ice. Top with with ice cubes and add gin, dry and club soda. Top with sweet vermouths, orange juice, a touch of whipped Grand Marnier and orange bitters. Shake well.

Strain into a large cocktail glass. **Bloody Mary**

4 ounces tomato juice 3 ounces vodka

1 ounce freshly squeezed lemon

1 dash Louisiana-style hot sauce 1 dash Worcestershire sauce 1/4 teaspoon celery salt

salt and freshly ground black

celery stalk, dill pickle spear or pickled green bean for garnish

Fill a pint glass three-quarters full with ice cubes. Add the tomato juice, vodka, lemon juice, hot sauce, Worcestershire sauce, celery salt and salt and pepper. Stir well. Add garnish.

Witch's Brew

ice cubes 1 1/2 ounces Strega 1/2 ounce white creme de men-

1/2 ounce freshly squeezed lemon

1/2 ounce freshly squeezed orange juice

1/4 ounce Pernod lemon slice for garnish fresh mint sprig

Fill cocktail shaker halfway full with ice cubes and add the Strega, creme de menthe, lemon juice and orange juice. Shake well.

Strain into a cocktail glass. Float the Pernod on top. Garnish with the lemon slice or mint sprig.
