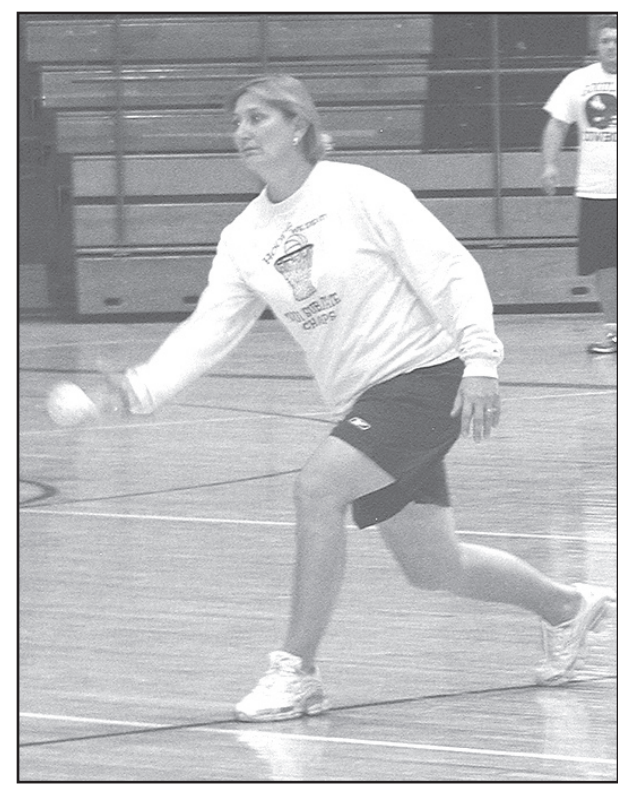


Fighting Rainbows beat teachers at wiffleball
