Notice Concerning Proposed Kansas Air Quality Class I Operating Permit Significant Modification

Notice is hereby given that the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is soliciting comments regarding four (4) proposed air quality permits. Archer Daniels Midland Company - Northern Sun, Company, Goodland, Kansas has applied for the following permits: 1) a

Construction Permit to conduct multi-seed oil extraction operations; 2) a clarification of existing permit conditions in a construction permit dated May 16, 1995; 3) a Construction Approval which incorporates the requirements of the EPA Consent Decree, filed August 21, 2003, United States vs. ADM, Civil Action Number 03-CV-2066; and 4) a Significant Modification to the Class I operating permit in accordance with the provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-510 et al. The purpose of the Significant Modification to the Class I permit is to incorporate the changes made by issuance of the construction approvals or permits described above, and identify the sources and types of regulated air pollutants emitted from the facility; the emission limitations, standards and requirements applicable to each source; and the monitoring, record keeping and reporting requirements applicable to each source as of the effective date of permit issuance.

Archer Daniels Midland Company - Northern Sun, Company, 6425 State Road, Goodland, KS 67735, owns and operates an existing Sunflower Seed Oil processing plant located at 6425 State Road, Goodland, KS 67735.

A copy of the proposed permits, permit applications, all supporting documentation, and all information relied upon during the permit application review process are available for a 30 day public review during normal business hours at the KDHE, Bureau of Air and Radiation (BAR), 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366. Also, a copy of the proposed permits only can be reviewed at the KDHE Northwest District Office, 2301 East 13th Street, Hays, Kansas 67601-2651. To obtain or review the proposed permits and supporting documentation, contact Lynelle Stranghoner, (785) 296-1719, at the central office of the KDHE, and to review the proposed permits only, contact Richard Robinson, (785) 625-5663, at the KDHE Northwest District Office. The standard departmental cost will be assessed for any copies requested.

Direct written comments or questions regarding the proposed permit to Lynelle Stranghoner, KDHE, BAR, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366, (785) 296-1719. In order to be considered in formulating a final permit decision, written comments must be received no later than noon on December 29, 2008.

Any member of the public may request to hold a public hearing to receive comments on the proposed issuance of the draft air quality permits. Written requests to hold a public hearing should be sent to the attention of Ms. Sharon Burrell at the address listed above, or by FAX to (785) 296-7455, and must be received by noon on Monday, December 29, 2008, in order for the Secretary of Health and Environment to consider the request.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) has a 45-day review period, which will start concurrently with the 30-day public comment period, within which to object to the proposed permit. If the USEPA has not objected in writing to the issuance of the permit within the 45-day review period, any person may petition the administrator of the USEPA to review the permit. The 60-day public petition period will directly follow the USEPA 45 day review period. Interested parties may contact KDHE to determine if the USEPA 45-day review period has been waived.

Any such petition shall be

based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the public comment period provided for in this notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates that it was impracticable to raise such objections within such period, or unless the grounds for such objection arose after such period. Contact Patricia Scott, USEPA, Region VII, Air Permitting and Compliance Branch, 901 N. 5th Street, Kansas City, Kansas 66101, (913) 551-7622, to determine when the 45 day USEPA review period ends and the 60 day petition period commences.
