The winter sports season is underway at Goodland High School, as the boys and girls basketball teams were to open at home Thursday while the Cowboys wrestling team was to compete in Hoxie.

The Cowboys C-team basketball game was to begin at 3:45 p.m. at the Max Jones Fieldhouse, the girls varsity and boys junior varsity at 6 and the boys varsity and girls junior varsity at 7. The wrestling dual was to begin at 5:30 p.m.

Sports will continue this weekend, with the Cowboys and Cowgirls basketball teams competing in Imperial, Neb., tonight, the girls varsity and boys junior varsity beginning at 5:30 p.m. with the boys varsity and girls junior varsity to follow.

Cowboys wrestling will be Saturday with the varsity team traveling to St. Francis for a tournament at 8:30 a.m. (Mountain Time) and the junior varsity team holding a home tournament beginning at 9 a.m. at the fieldhouse.

The Cowboys wrestlers will have a home dual at 5:30 p.m. Thursday against Atwood in the high school gym and will go to Colby for a

tournament beginning at 1 p.m. next Friday and 7 a.m. Saturday.

The Cowboys and Cowgirls basketball teams will hold the Topside Tip-off tournament from Thursday through next Saturday.

The boys bracket begins at 2 p.m. Thursday with Ottawa vs. Norton in the junior high gym at Max Jones. Burlington will face Wallace County (Sharon Springs) at 4 p.m. in the fieldhouse, McCook faces Weskan at 6 p.m. in the junior high gym and Goodland will open against Wray, Colo., in the fieldhouse.

The girls bracket will begin with Wray vs. Wallace County at 2 p.m. Thursday in the fieldhouse. McCook will face Norton at 4 p.m. in the junior high gym, Goodland will face Ottawa at 6 p.m. in the fieldhouse and Weskan will face Burlington at 8 p.m. in the junior high gym.

The girls championship game will be at 5 p.m. Saturday in the fieldhouse, and the boys championship game will be at 7 p.m.

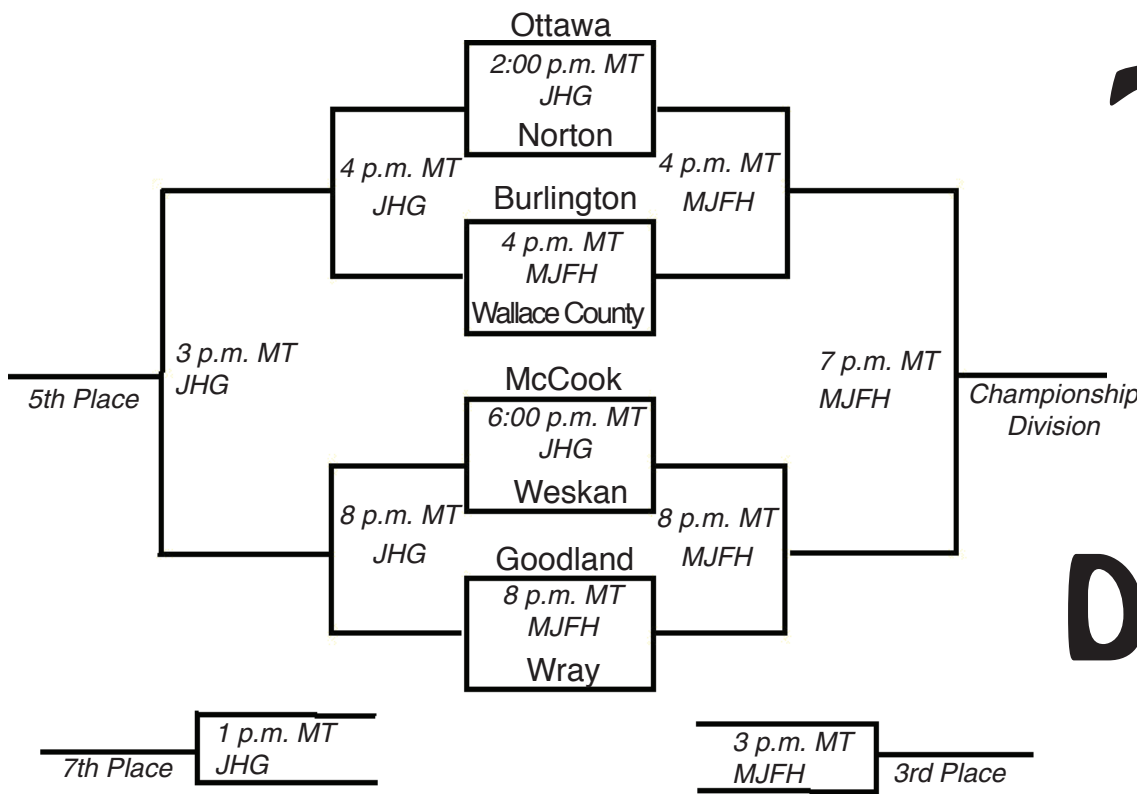
