Cowboys beat Hoxie, finish second in tourney

Most of the points were earned by pins, but a technical fall and two forfeits ended up tipping the scales in the Goodland High School wrestling team's 47-34 win against the Hoxie Indians Thursday.

The Cowboys finished second in the St. Francis tournament Saturday with two finishing first in their weight class, three second, two third and two fourth.

At Hoxie, the Cowboys had five pins, a technical fall and two forfeits to the Indians'

five pins and one decision.

The Cowboys opened the dual with a win, as freshman Austin Avelar pinned Hoxie's Drew Jones at 103 pounds. The Indians tied the score in the next match, as freshman Corey Davis was pinned by Kollyn Schippers at 112.

The Cowboys got back on top, though, with sophomore Seth Miller pinning Chris Heim at 119. Senior Kade Sheldon added to Goodland's lead, pinning Donovan Schamberger at 125.

The Cowboys fell behind, though, losing

four in a row, as sophomore Chris Bustillos was pinned by Trevor Popp at 130, sophomore Kayler Rietcheck was pinned by Britton Sealock at 135, senior Hector Sarinana was pinned by Cayle Taylor at 140 and junior Lorenzo Delgado was pinned by Dylan Bainter at 145.

Senior Keegan Smith earned five points for Goodland, beating Clayton Schamberger in a technical fall at 152, senior Vance Johnson pinned Jeff Shaw at 160 and senior Ryan Taylor won by forfeit at 171.

Senior Fernando Martinez pinned Danny

Baker at 189, and senior Tanner Oharah won by forfeit at 215, putting Goodland up 47-30. Junior Jay Cotter lost in a 10-2 decision to Dillon Salmans at 285.

In the junior varsity matches, freshman Mikail Freeman was pinned by John Garret, freshman Sloan Ruhs beat Garret in a 4-0 decision and Freeman was pinned by Colt Spresser.

At St. Francis, Goodland earned 141 points for second place. Colby won the tournament with 201, Scott City was third with 111 and Burlington was fourth.

Senior Keegan Smith was first at 152, and sophomore Seth Miller won at 119. Freshman Austin Avelar was second at 103, senior Ryan Taylor second at 171 and senior Vance Johnson second at 171.

Seniors Fernando Martinez and Kade Sheldon were third at 189 and 125, respectively. Juniors Lorenzo Delgado and Jay Cotter finished fourth at 145 and 285.

Complete results from St. Francis are planned for a future edition.

The Brewster Bulldogs beat Cheylin (Bird City) 66-37, and the Lady Bulldogs beat Cheylin 55-44 Friday at home.

For the boys, Spencer Holm led with 14 points, followed by Seth Carpenter and Seth Ackerman, each with 13, Devan Selby with 11, Troy Albers with 8, Erik Roeder with 6 and Tate Preston with 1.

The Bulldogs took an early lead, scoring 20 in the first quarter to Bird City's 4 and scored 21 in the second to Bird City's five, going into half-time ahead 41-9. In the third, Bird

City scored 11 to Brewster's 4, and in the fourth, Brewster scored 21 to Bird City's 17.

For the Lady Bulldogs, Melissa Crumrine led with 16 points, followed by Britt Kammer with 12, R. Bear with 11, Nichelle Erskine with 10, K. Hoyt with 3, A. Bremerkamp with 2 and S. Rall with 1.

Brewster scored 12 in the first quarter to Bird City's 10, then Bird City scored 14 in the second quarter to Brewster's 12, sending the teams to the locker rooms tied 24-24 at the half.

The Lady Bulldogs scored 18 in the third quarter to Bird City's 8 and 13 in the fourth to Bird City's 10.
