

# Bowl team places third

To earn third place in their fourth meet of the season, the Goodland Scholars' Bowl team journeyed to Atwood on Thursday, Dec. 4, and competed against Hoxie, Wheatland, Quinter, Norton, Oberlin, Oakley, Atwood, Golden Plains and Colby.

Team members, TJ Freeman, Brad Geist, Page Seeger, Parker Sieck and Ben Waugh were working off their successes at Goodland and Greeley County to garner bronze medals. In earlier meets, Garrett Nemechek, Bobbie Jo Ray, and Tiffany Skinner also participated.

"The team seems to have developed a better rhythm with their responses," said Coach Elaine Felver. "Their eighth-round loss to Golden Plains put them into a bit of a slump and they had a brain-drain against

Colby, but they were able to secure third place. It's always good to come home with hardware!"

This was one of the questions the Scholars' Bowl team encountered on its fifth outing of the season at Colby High School on Monday, Dec. 8. Members Freeman, Geist, Nemechek, Seeger, Sieck and Skinner participated. They finished out of the rankings for semi-finals.

A sampling of other questions included the following: Which early American's image is on the \$100 bill? Ships from 10 nations jointly

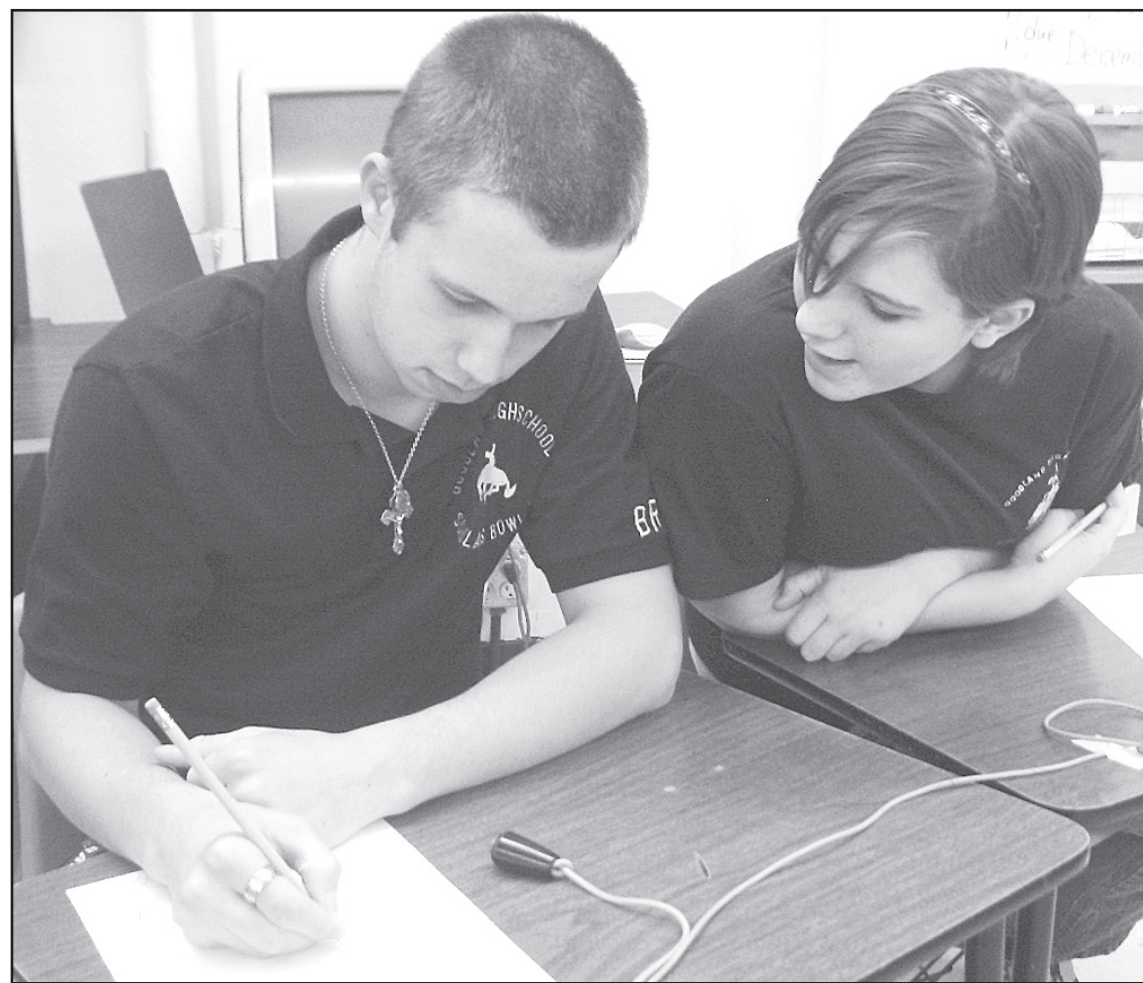
patrolled in October to protect shipping from pirates. From what country do the pirates operate?

What was the title of the Charles Dickens novel left unfinished at his death?

"There seemed to be a consensus among other coaches and participants that the questions were quite difficult," said Coach Felver. "Our kids dug down deep and came up with some hard ones, but we were disappointed in the outcome. We'll do better at the next one."

So what are the correct answers to the above questions? The vegetable was spinach; the early American, Benjamin Franklin; the nation, Somalia; and the novel, "The Mystery of Edwin Drood."
