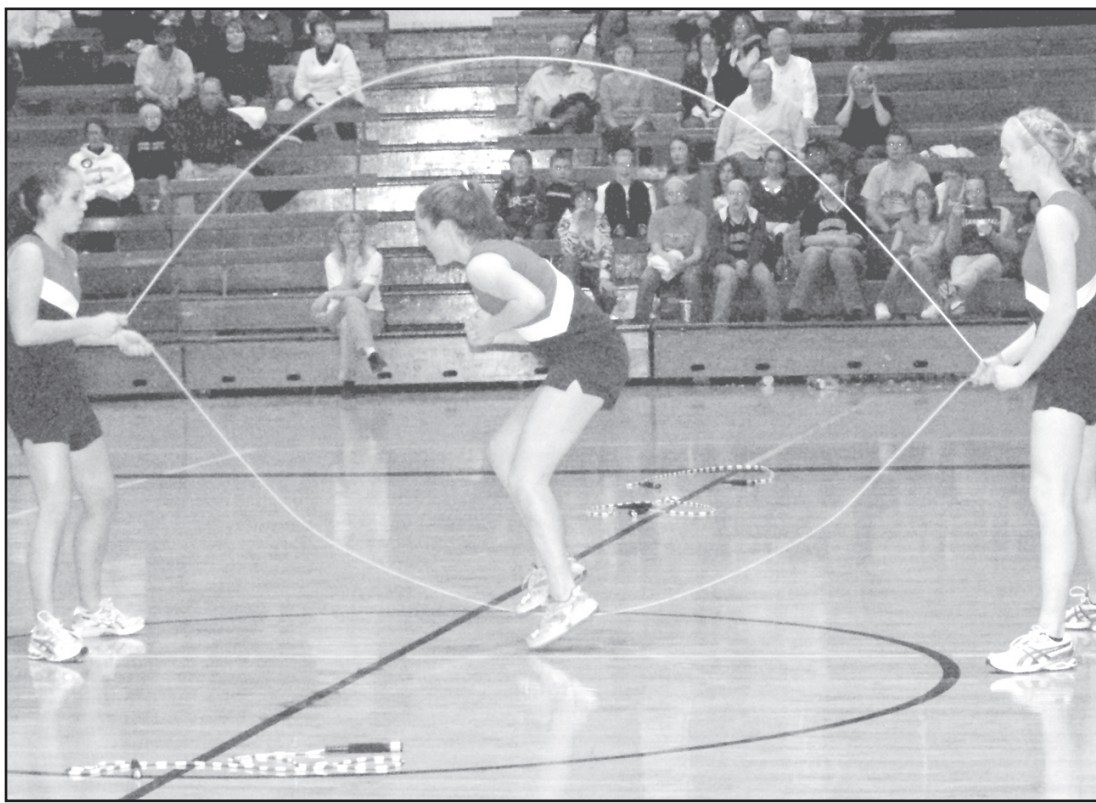


Skip It entertains at Topside Tip-Off
