



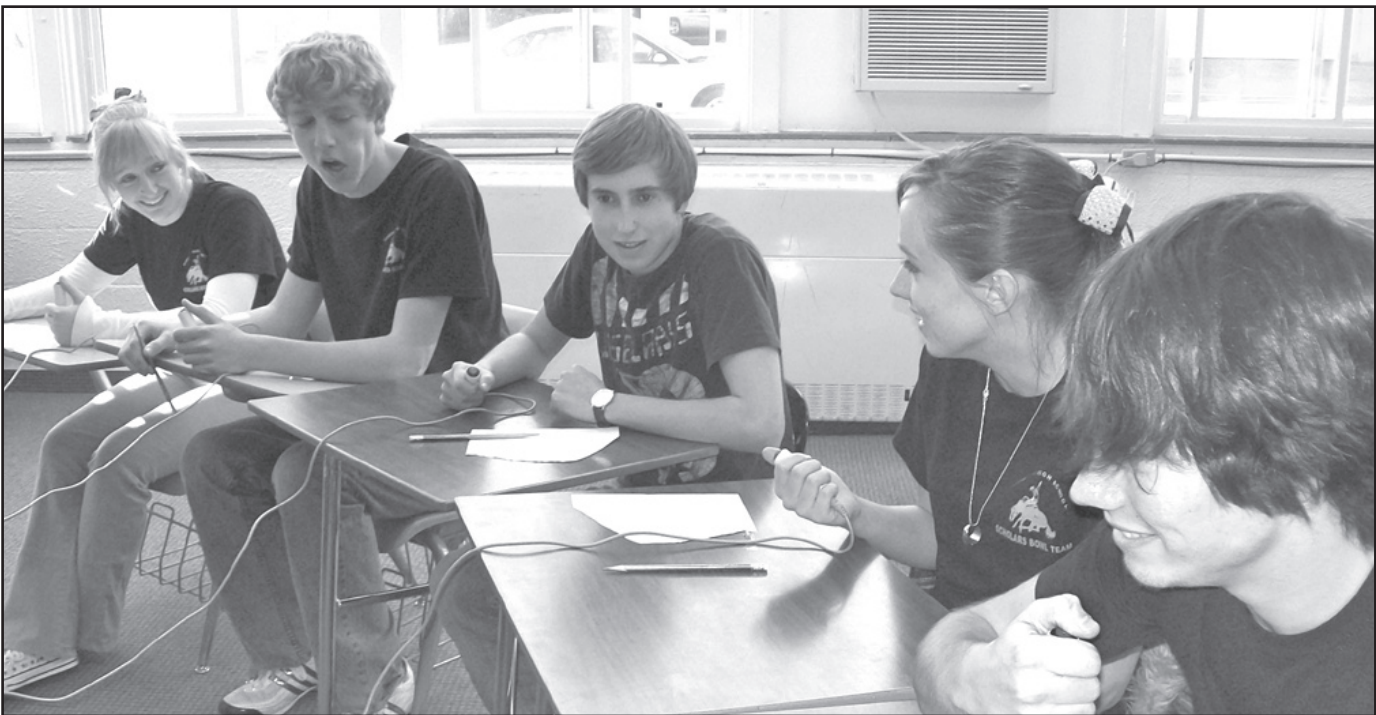

Scholars' Bowl team wins league title

After the long winter break, the Goodland High School Scholars' Bowl team came back in winning form to capture league title at Oakley on Monday, Jan. 11.

Captained by Ben Waugh with Parker Sieck as co-captain, the competitors also included Michaela Garrett, J.L. Pourin, and Day Waugh.

Coach Jon Felver commented, "We won two tie-breakers and lost only one round. The team was really focused today." He also noted that foreign exchange student Pourin from France answered the last question and earned the last team point of the day.

The event in Oakley was designed to be straight tournament play to include the seven league teams in seven rounds. No second or third place and no other medals were awarded. Other participating groups were Oberlin, Hoxie, Quinter, Atwood, Colby and Oakley. Felver noted that due to plans to restructure the league, this may be the last year Goodland faces some of these teams.

Team competes with new league members

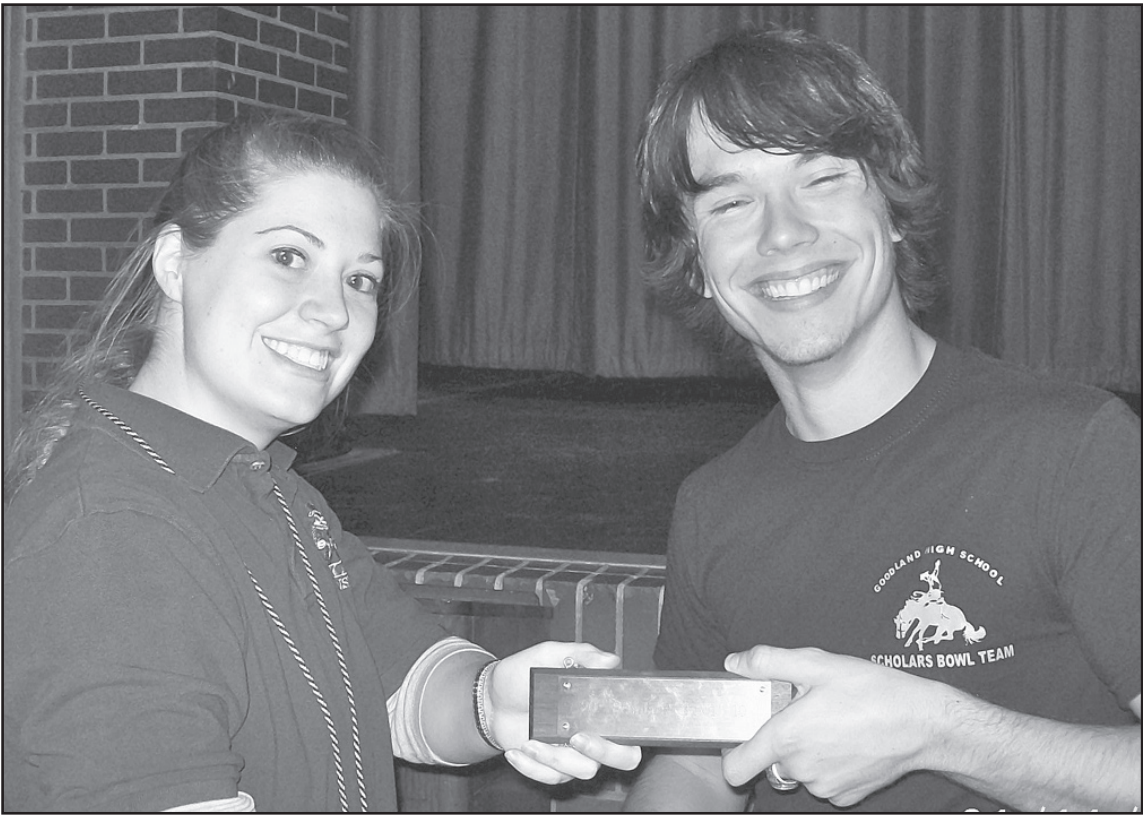

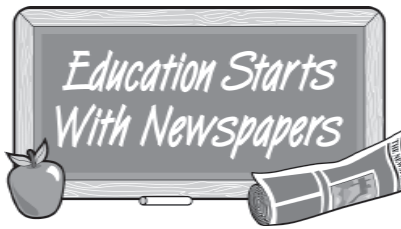
