The Cowgirls (10-7) have won three games in a row and tip off at 5:30 p.m. tonight against the Lady Plainsmen (13-2), who are coming off back to back wins against Rawlins County and Brewster.

Junior Brock Wilkens leads the Cowboys in scoring, averaging

10.6 points per game. Sophomore Ryan Hillmer is averaging 8.6 points. Junior Robert Cowan is averaging 7.7 points. Sophomore Blaine Luther is averaging 4 points. Brenner is averaging 3.3 points. Junior Garth Helton is averaging

2.8 points. Amthor is averaging 2.4 points. Sophomore Reed Bellamy is averaging 2.2 points.

As a team the Cowboys are averaging 42.5 per game and are hitting 39 percent from the floor, 24 percent from the 3-point line and 50 percent of the free throws.

Amthor leads the team in assists with 29, Wilkens 19, Hillmer 15 and Brenner 11.

Wilkens leads the team in rebounds with 115 for an average of 6.4 per game. Cowan has 83 for an average of 4.6 per game. Brenner has 47 for an average of 3.1. Amthor has 49 for an average of 2.7. Hillmer has 48 for an average of 2.7.

The Cowboys close out the regular season on the road at Colby on Tuesday and at Hoxie on Friday. Substate play begins on Monday, March 1.

The Cowboys "C" team will play at 6 p.m. on Monday at Cheylin in Bird City.
