a sister-in-law, Dorothy Douglas of Overland Park; 11 grandchildren; 18 great grandchildren; and two great great grandchildren.

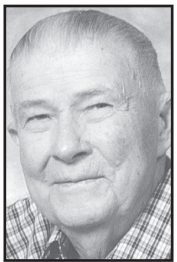
