One of the fax solicitations offered "complete health care plans" but did not list an insurance agency, agent or company, only a phone number. 'When dealing with unknown or out-of-state insurance companies," Commissioner Praeger said, 'we always urge Kansas consumers to 'Stop. Call. Confirm.' Stop your tranaction, call our consumer assistance representatives and confirm that the company is licensed and in good standing in Kansas."
