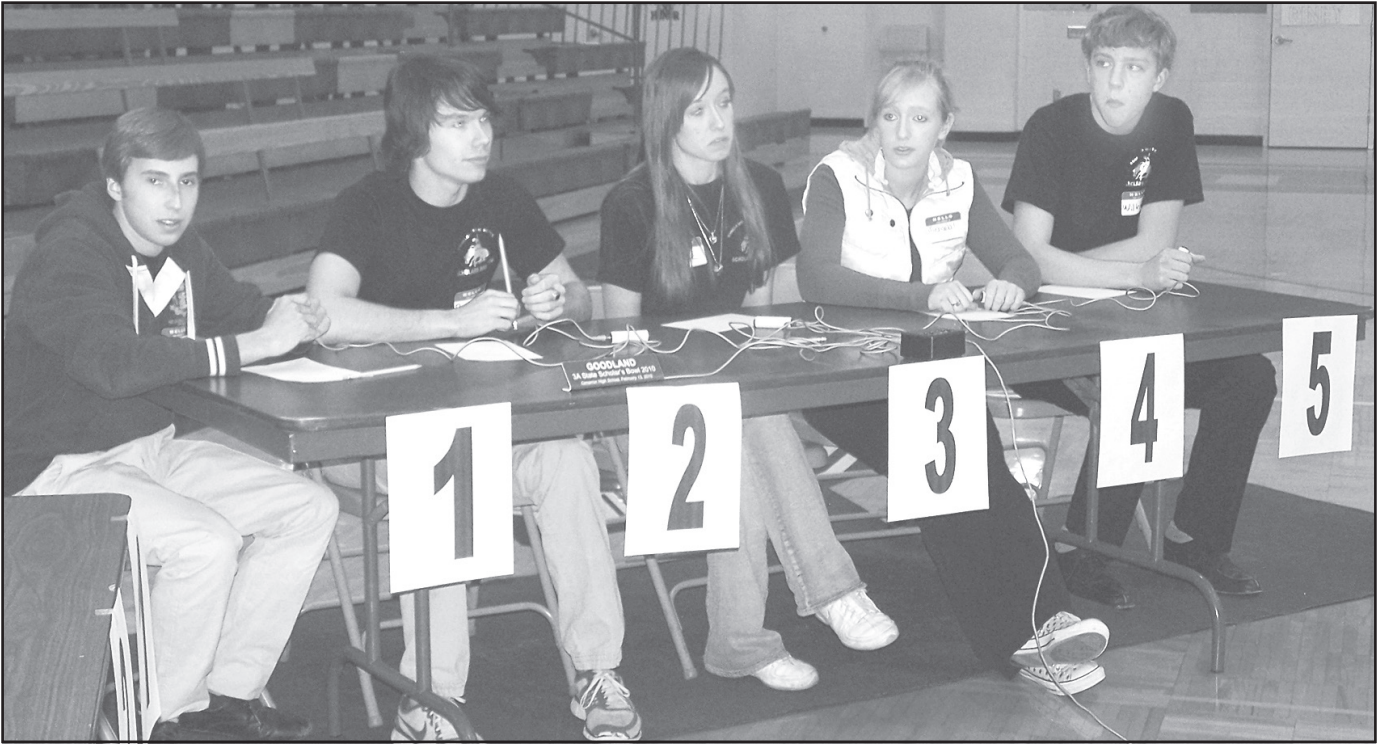

Scholars' Bowl team makes first appearance at state tournament

"To be one of the final 12 teams at the 3A State Scholars' Bowl in Cimarron was an honor," noted Felver.
