# Cowboy wrestler finishes fourth at state tourney

The Goodland Cowboys' Jay Cotter placed fourth in the 285-pound weight class in the 3-2-1A State Wrestling Championships held at Gross Memorial Coliseum on the campus of Fort Hays State University Friday and Saturday. Cotter was one of three Cowboys who qualified for state by virtue of their results at the regional meet at Norton a week ago.

Seth Miller, in the 125-pound weight class, lost in the first round and then again in the consolation second round at the state showdown to be eliminated.

Nathan Deeds, in the 140 pound weight class, lost in the first round and got all the way to the consolation quarter finals before he was eliminated. from the state mats. Cotter defeated Seth Suelter of Lincoln, 11-0, in the first round. In the second round he was defeated by Cody Huffman of Douglass, 5-1. On the consolation side of the bracket Cotter beat Jacob Owen of Hoisington by a fall. He advanced to beat Jesse Barnes of Thomas More Prep-Hays, 3-2, Cotter beat his next

opponent Dakota Denny of Carney-Carney Valley, 9-1. For third place Cotter wrestled Jared Rice of Phillipsburg. He lost by a fall, but earned the right to stand on the podium and receive a 4th-place medal.

In the first round Miller lost to Riley Soward of Halsted, 9-1. In the consolation bracket he beat Jose Munoz of Holcomb, 6-4. In the next match against Hunter Stalford of Carney-Carney Valley he lost 4-0 to be eliminated.

Deeds lost his first round match against Cody Wildin of Marion, 7-3. In the consolation bracket he beat Jacob Morris of Stafford, 7-2. Next he wrestled and beat Coulter Craft of Montezuma-South Gray, 2-0. In his final match against Brandon Melcher of Herington he lost, 10-4.

Team-wise, Norton won the state championship with 174.5 points. Second was Smith Center with 80.5, Oakley was third with 68 points, Hoxie was fifth with 59.5, Thomas More Prep-Hays tied for tenth with 52 points. Goodland placed 34th with 19 points.
