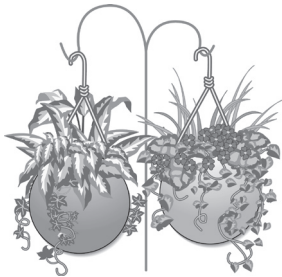

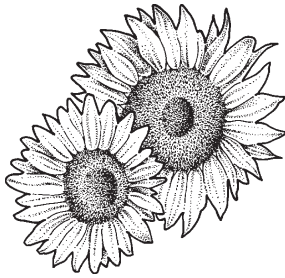

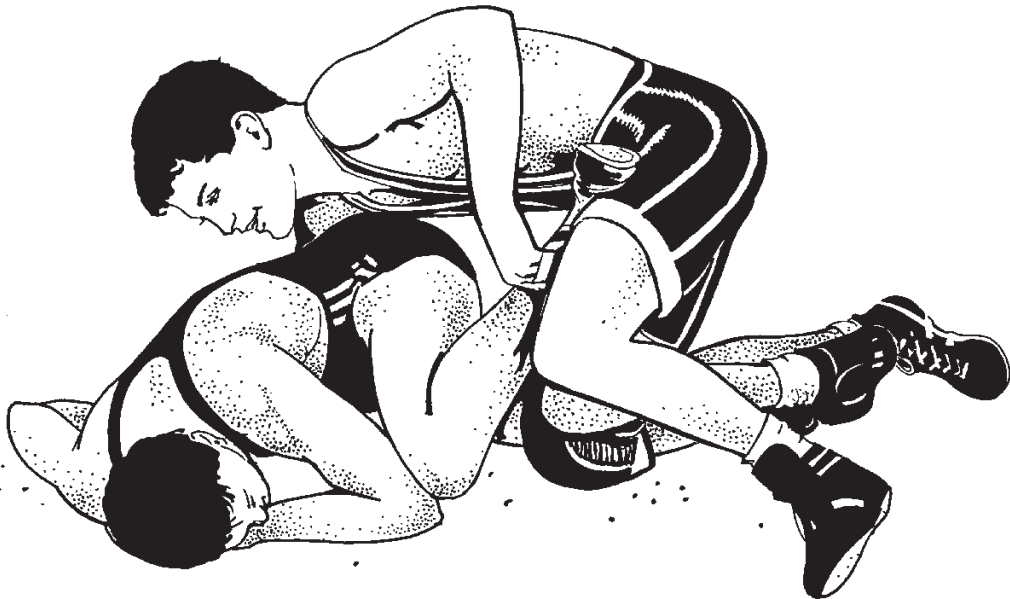
“I might add we had 11 wrestlers going
