

Cowgirls lose to Monarchs in sub-state, 51-32

The Goodland Cowgirls lost 51-32 to the Thomas More Prep-Marian Monarchs on Friday in the semi-finals of the Lakin Class 3A Sub-State Tournament. The loss put the Cowgirls at 11-11 for the season. TMP-Marian improved their record to 20-1 with the victory.

The Cowgirls were able to stay with the Monarchs in the first quarter, but then the reason the Hays bunch lost only one game all season became apparent.

The Cowgirls played toe to toe with the Monarchs in the opening period and even held the lead at one point. For the remainder of the game, however, Hays out-rebounded and out-scored the Cowgirls. The Cowgirls couldn't seem to find the basket.

The Monarchs took possession of the ball after the tip off. Rachel Jacobs missed her first shot but got

the rebound and put it in during the first minute of the game. In the Cowgirls' second possession of the ball, Paige Phillips was fouled by TMP's Jenna Lang and she hit one of the two shot for the first Cowgirls' points of the game. That made the score Hays 2-1. Ashley Archer stole the ball from TMP after a rebound. It ended up in a jump ball. At 6:00 Jade Herl made a three-point shot giving Goodland the lead, 4-2.

When Archer committed the first foul of the night for the Cowgirls, TMP's Rachel Jacobs made both shots to tie the score 4-4. Archer added another point from the charity stripe at 4:25 into the quarter. TMP's Jessa Stramel made the next basket for the Monarchs. Archer added two points. With under two minutes left in the quarter Archer hit a three-point shot. TMP's Jacobs added two three-point shots before the buzzer making the score TMP 14-10.

Herl added a basket shortly after

the start of the second quarter. Christy Studer hit a basket at 4:55 and she also made a point from the charity stripe. In the second quarter TMP scored 16 points to Goodland's 5.

TMP continued its domination in the third quarter. Goodland scored seven points to TMP's 13. Alexis Bateman added two points to the score from the charity stripe. Goodland just couldn't get the ball through the hoop. The score was TMP, 43-22.

The Cowgirls outscored TMP in the fourth quarter, 10-8, but it was way too little too late. Archer made eight of the 10 points and Herl the other two.

The top scorer in the game was Archer with 17. Herl had nine, Studer three, Bateman two and Phillips one.

TMP advanced to the state 3A finals by beating Kismet-Southwestern Heights, 51-47.
