

Goodland qualifies 34 for district championships

Goodland Wrestling Club qualified 34 wrestlers for the District 4 Kansas Kids Championships to be held Saturday at Max Jones Fieldhouse.

The district championships will feature Kansas Kid wrestlers from 35 teams from western Kansas to qualify for the Kansas Kids Championships to be held March 27-28 at the Topeka Expocenter.

Goodland took 42 wrestlers to the Sub-District tournament Saturday in WaKeeney and had 34 finish in the top four to qualify for the District tournament.

Seven Goodland wrestlers placed first including D.J. Knox, 8 and under, 43 pounds; Tate Withington, 10 and Under, 61 pounds; Evan Peter, 10 and Under, 100 pounds; Luis Ledesma, 10 and Under, 150 pounds; Drew House, 12 and Under, 165 pounds; and in the high school division Seth Miller, 130 pounds, and Lorenzo Delgado, 150 pounds.

Ten Goodland wrestlers placed second at WaKeeney including Octavio Gonzales, 8 and under, 43 pounds; Mason Hernandez, 8 and under 46 pounds; Dawson Holub, 8 and Under 67 pounds; Tayton Weeter, 8 and Under 70 pounds; Ryan Volk 8 and Under 125 pounds; Aaron Avelar, 14 and Under, 90 pounds; Tyler Gastineau, 14 and Under 130 pounds; John Peden, 14 and Under 145 pounds; Ian Bonsall, 14 and Under 165 pounds; and Marvin Hernandez, high school division, 115 pounds.

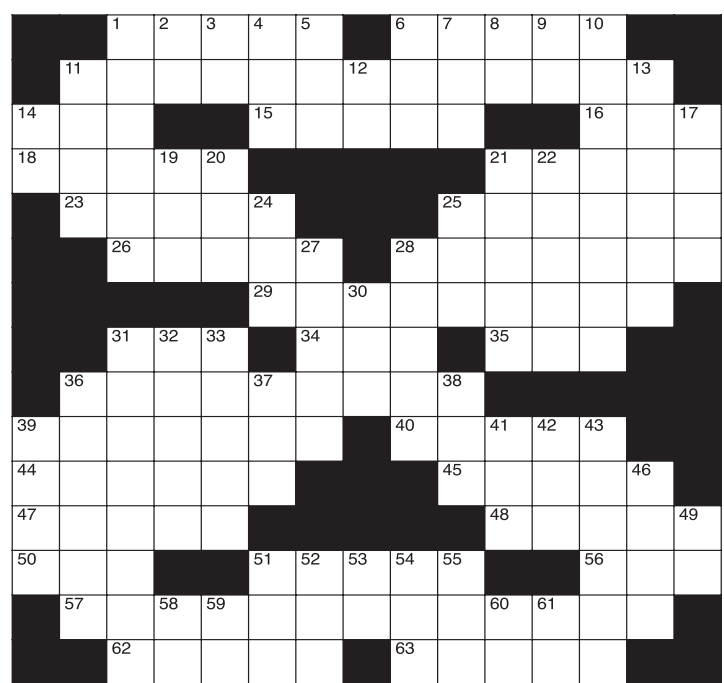
