Two Cowboys receive league Honorable Mention

Two Cowboys were named as Honorable Mentions in the Northwest Kansas All-League basketball team.

Cowboys junior Brock Wilkens and sophomore Ryan Hillmer were part of the Honorable Mentions for the all-league team for the past basketball season.

Wilkens led the Cowboys in scoring averaging 9.9 points per game hitting 49 percent of his shots, and Hillmer was a close second with 9.3 points per game hitting 33 percent of his shots. Wilkens led the team in

rebounds with 128. Hillmer had 56 rebounds and 22 assists.

Robert Cowan averaged 8.7 points a game, senior Landon Brenner 3.5 and senior Kevin Amthor 2.1. Amthor led the team in assists with 27 and had 53 rebounds. Brenner had 12 assists and 52 rebounds. Cowan had 6 assists and was second in rebounds with 106.

The Cowboys finished the season 4-17, and Coach Don Smith said he felt the boys had improved a lot during the year. He said with a few breaks in the final minutes of several

games the team record would have been much better.

Named to the All-League team were three from Quinter including seniors Matt Bird, Scott Ochs and Brady Reed; two from Hoxie including senior Taylor Rall and sophomore Jasxen Moss; two from St. Francis including seniors Matt Raile and Trent Raile; two from Colby including senior Braden McKee and junior Corbin Stephens; and one from Oakley junior Patrick Loftus.

Others on included in the Honor-

able Mentions two from Oakley senior Patrick Ahrens and Tad Parsons; two from Rawlins County juniors Brandon Rutherford and Keaton Argabright; one from Quinter senior Zach Nemecek and one from Oberlin junior Dakota Soderlund.

Kids District tourney brings 35 teams to town Saturday

The District 4 Kansas Kids Championships will feature wrestlers from 35 teams from western Kansas beginning at 8 a.m. on Saturday at Max Jones Fieldhouse.

The Goodland Wrestling Club is the host for the district tournament and will have 34 wrestlers trying to qualify for the Kansas Kids Championships to be held March 27-28 at the Topeka ExpoCenter.

The top four in each class will qualify for the state tournament.

Weigh-in will be held from 5-7 p.m. on Friday, and from 4:30-7 a.m. on Saturday at Max Jones Fieldhouse, 1304 Arcade. Coaches meeting at 7:30 a.m. and wrestling begins at 8 a.m.

Goodland wrestlers participated in tournaments in Hays, Ulysses and Pratt prior to the sub-districts.

At the Western Kansas Classic at Gross Memorial at Fort Hays State University on March 6, Goodland had five wrestlers place first, four place second, three place third and four place fourth.

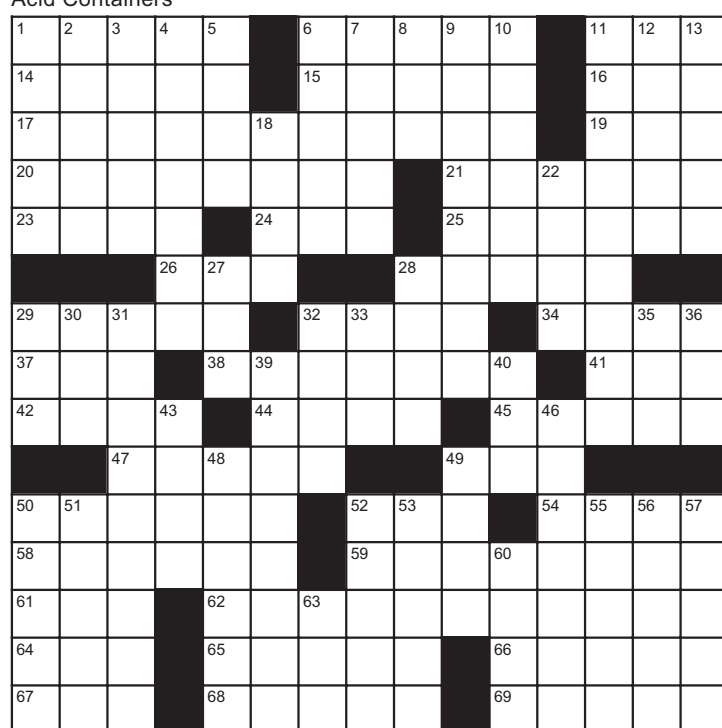
Adrienne Pauls.
