

# Former Goodland man named coach of the year

Burlington High Cougar wrestling coach Doug Duell, who has coached 26 years, has been named *The Denver Post's* wrestling coach of the year in all classifications.

His recognition complements the Cougars winning the 2A state title.

Duell, who was named coach of the year in the 2A division, said the honors he receives are only reflections of his team. Duell is the eldest son of Ben Duell of Ruleton and a 1975 graduate of Goodland High School.

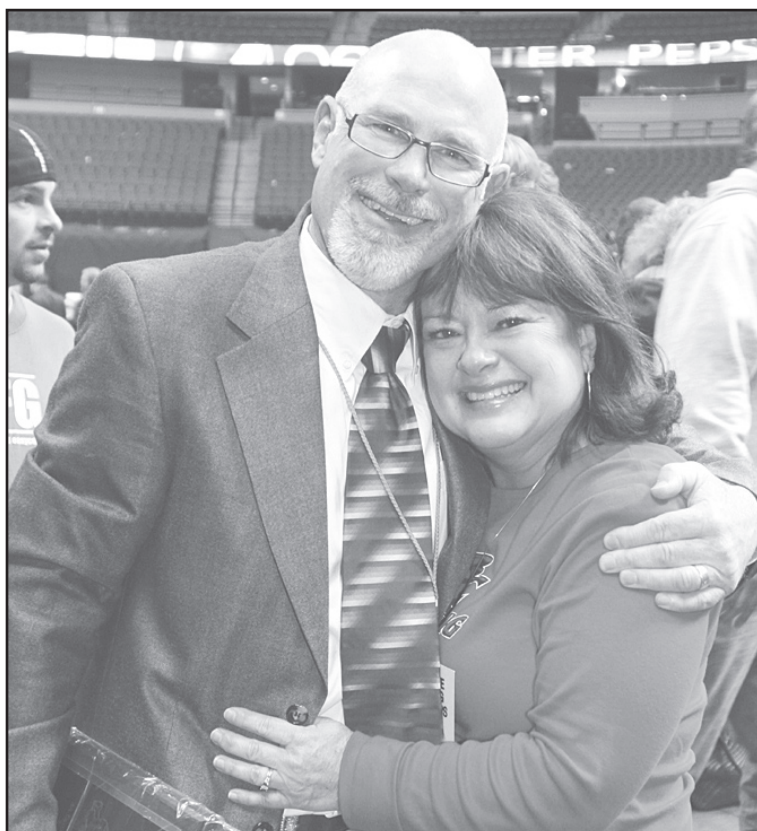
"This was one of those seasons you kind of dream about but there are so many things that come to mind about this team and this year. Really, truly, this was a great bunch of young men," Duell said.

Cougar seniors Bon Kinder and Isaiah Churchwell were named to the *Post's* Class 2A first-team. Kinder wrestled at 125 pounds and Churchwell was a heavyweight. Both won state titles in their weight class.

Mike Satterly was named to the *Post's* 2A second team. A senior, Satterly placed second at 215 pounds.

Colin Eberhart (130 pound, junior), Gabe Lerma (160 pound, senior), Trenton Rico (140 pound, junior) and Miguel Torres (103 pound, sophomore) received honorable mention. Torres and Eberhart placed third at state. Rico and Lerma placed fourth at state.

Duell will be named the high school coach of the year for Colorado by the Colorado Chapter of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame on April 24 at the U.S. Air Force Academy. Duell said none of these honors would have happened

without a team having certain characteristics.

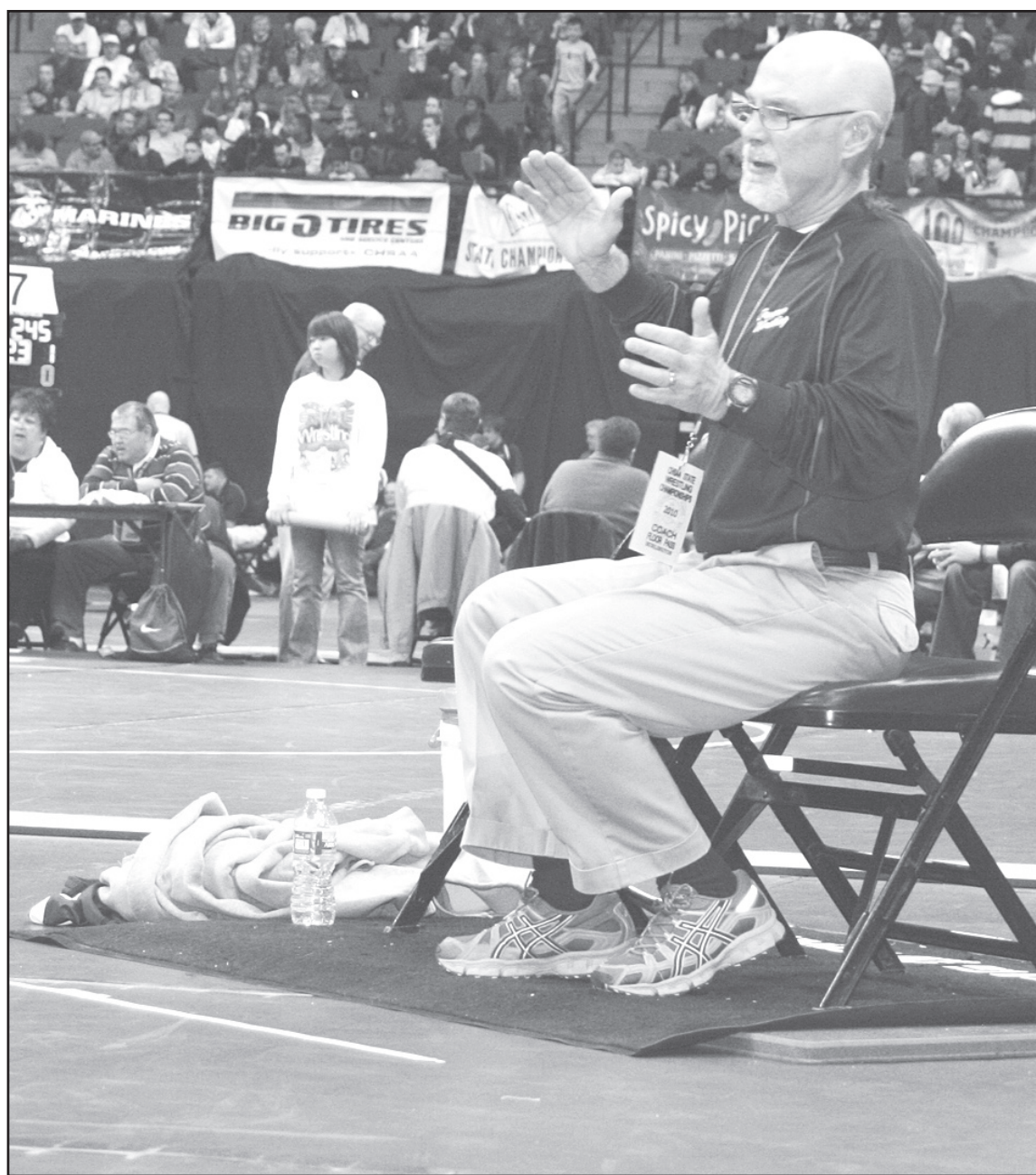
"As I said at our banquet, the best thing about this group of young men is not what they accomplished on the mat, it goes beyond that. It is evident in the number of juniors and seniors who receive high academic awards. This team has a lot of character and when I say team, I mean team."

"I'm not just talking about varsity or kids at state. I'm talking about every single kid who was in that practice room all year. That is what helped make this team what it was and responsible for the success we had this year."

The event at the Air Force Academy is open to the public. Tickets are \$45 before April 14, and increase to \$50 after that date. The event is from 4 to 8 p.m. Colorado State Wrestling awards will be presented from 5 to 5:30 p.m. with a dinner to follow. National awards will be presented from 6:30 to 8 p.m. Formal attire is required.

- Kidney stones

- Management of dialysis patients, transplant patients and those with end stage renal disease

One of the biggest benefits of this addition to Hays Medical Center is that the hospital now has greater capacity to care for patients in need of regular dialysis. While the hospital previously treated dialysis patients, they can now treat more patients – and patients who need a higher level of care – eliminating the burden and stress of travel for additional families in the area.

Dr. McCullagh, a Wichita native, grew up in Kansas City and completed her education

at the University of Kansas School of Medicine. She completed both her residency in Internal Medicine and her fellowship in Nephrology and Hypertension at the University of Kansas Medical Center. Dr. McCullagh is certified by the American Board of Internal Medicine and holds memberships with the American Society of Nephrology, American College of Physicians and the American Medical Association.

Wanting to stay within driving distance of family and friends, Dr. McCullagh and her family were excited to make the move to Hays.

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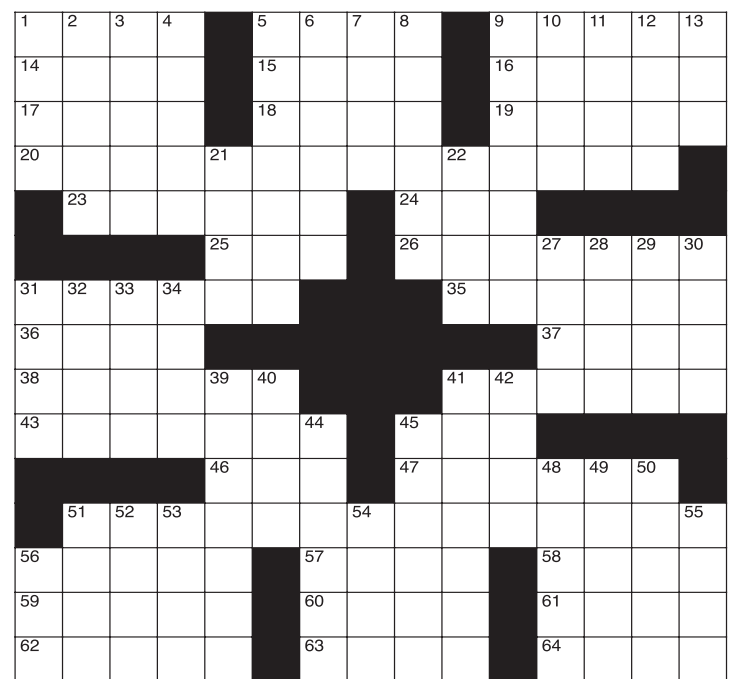
