# Sherman County Census returns reach 61 percent

nt.betz@nwkansas.com Sherman County's Census return rate has reached 61 percent Monday, but the national rate is up to 65 percent and the Kansas state average is 70 percent.

People are encouraged to mail in their U.S. Census forms with a deadline of May 1.

The latest return figures bring Sherman County within 4 percent of the 65 percent returned for the 2000 census, but the goal is to get the county closer to the 85 to 90 percent return rate.

The Kansas return rate is up to 70 percent. Other counties in northwest Kansas include Cheyenne 66 percent, Rawlins 56 percent, Decatur 58 percent, Thomas 66 percent, Sheridan 65 percent, Wallace 61 percent, Logan 66 percent, Gove 69 percent and the highest in the neighborhood Graham 72 percent.
