He said Reed Bellamy was the pitcher.

The Beavers won 11-0 in five innings.

"We had some chances in the second game," he said. "We were up against their number one pitcher and we did better. We had a lot of errors. We are having trouble making the simple plays, and there

were several dropped fly balls." He said Dallas DeLaRosa was

the pitcher, and while he gave up six runs half of those were unearned.

'We did not play very well over all," he said. "We are having trouble scoring our runners when we get them on base. It looks at time our bats are going to come to life.

"The guys have the potential to do well, but it is hard to get the consistency."

He said Brook Redlin is leading the team in hitting at .458.

The Cowboys were to be in Liberal for a doubleheader on Thursday, but weather caused a

postponement. A date for making up the games has not been set.

The Cowboys travel to Plainville on Tuesday for a doubleheader.

Mull said the next home games are with Larned and are scheduled for Friday, April 30 at 2 p.m..

'We are now 3-5," he said, "but we easily could be 5-3. I think we have a chance to do good things in the rest of our season.'
