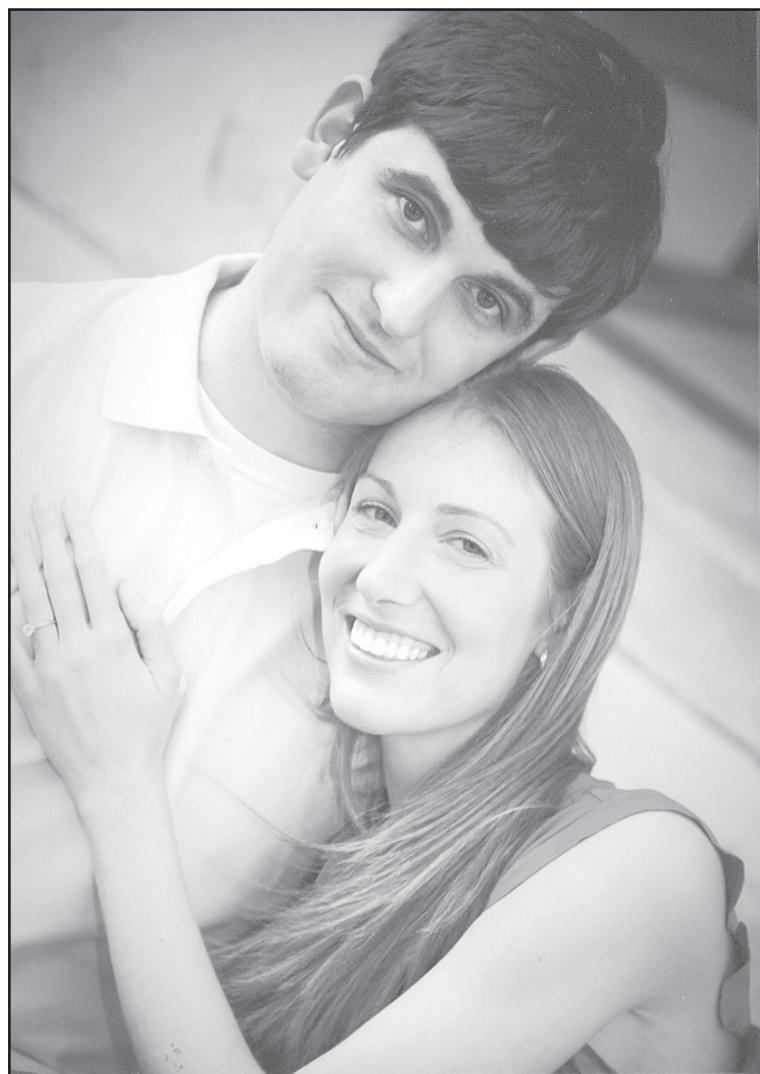

The future groom's parents are Scott and Deborah Mentzer of Goodland and his grandparents are the late John and Mary Mentzer

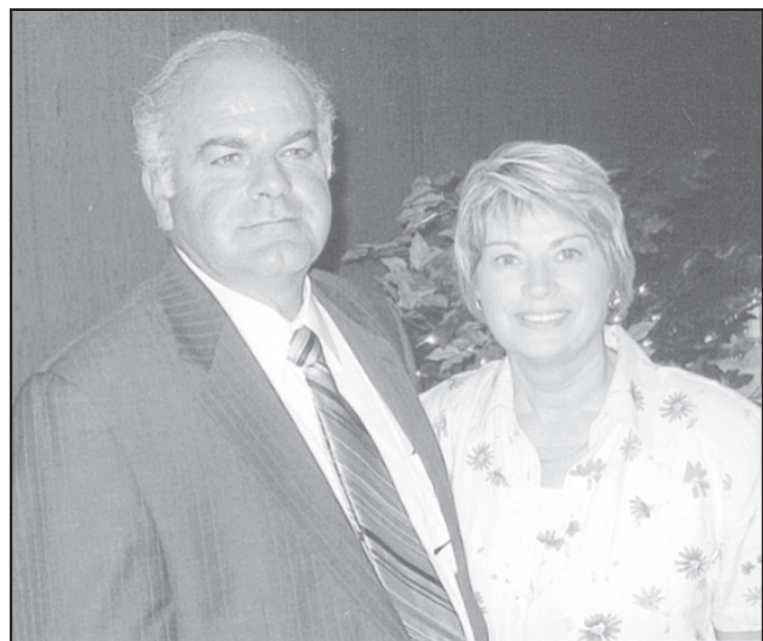
and the late Clarence and Marilyn Speed.
